**Subject: Monthly Activity Report: October 2024** 

ear Fellow Residents:
Hurricane Milton: Hurricane Milton hit LSR harder than any previous storms. While the damage to the Park could have been much worse, for some it was devastating. A summary of the damage follows:

- 29 homes in the Park sustained damage.
- 14 roofs were either damaged or completely removed by the high winds exposing the homes to the torrential rains from the storm.
- 17 carports were damaged or destroyed.
- Several homes lost siding, awnings, or had broken windows.
- Major potable water leaks were caused by the storm.
- Two major well water leaks were caused by the storm.
- The spa fencing was destroyed, the spa developed a leak, and several mechanical issues resulted from the storm.
- 15 palm trees were uprooted.
- The overhang in the maintenance shed was damaged.
- Leaks in the hall roof were noticed during the storm.
- Cameras in the Park are down (some were filled with water).
- One pavilion curtain needs to be replaced.

As a result of the damage throughout the Park, there remains debris littered in the Park and in Lake Seminole. The Board is working to get the debris cleaned up as quickly as possible.

Milton hit the area as a minor hurricane. If this had been a major storm, the damage would have been worse. There were still residents who refused to leave the Park even though Milton was expected to be much worse than it was. An emergency evacuation order was issued for all mobile homes in Pinellas County. Even with our buildings constructed of walls of cinder block, there are no buildings in the Park that are hurricane proof. Residents who remain in the Park during storms like Milton do so at their own peril. Power, water, and emergency services may not be available to the remaining residents for several days when a major storm hits the Park.

The Board has been contacted by some residents to check on their homes, both inside and outside. The Board does its best to notify residents of property damage, but it can take some time. The Board is not responsible for reporting damage, but does so as a convenience to the shareholders. The Board will not go into a home unless it is an emergency.

I have reports of some residents who are complaining of the length of time it is taking to remove debris and return the Park to a pristine condition. I ask that you put yourselves in the position of the people most affected. Roofs missing, carports damaged, windows broken, and siding blown off the homes. Many of us were not damaged by the high winds and water brought in by Milton.

A few were left with major damage that is life altering. The Board asks for patience from all residents while those affected try to get their life and possessions back in order.

The Board is in the process of organizing the clean-up of the lake which is LSR property. Please refrain from going into the lake as there are inherent risks in and around the lake including potential animal threats and disease.

There will necessarily be some inconvenience for all of us in the Park. Your understanding is appreciated.

Water Usage: A large water leak was repaired after Milton. The Board suspects there is another water leak somewhere in the Park since our usage is well above average for this time of year. Please keep an eye out for any signs of water pooling anywhere in the Park.

Well System: A large well water leak was repaired. There remains one leak under a resident's home that needs to be repaired. The well water connecting to this home has been shut off until the repair can be completed.

Tree Trimming: Trees will be trimmed in November.

Lake Weed Treatment: The Board is working with our lake weed service provider to put down preemergent treatment to inhibit lake weeds from coming up once the lake is refilled. The Board is also looking into cleaning up the cove and the boat dock to remove surface dirt.

# **WINTER SOLSTICE – DECEMBER 21, 2024**

# BINGO IS RETURNING TO THE LSR HALL ON JANUARY 6



# **Wearing your heart upon your sleeve**

**Y**ou've probably heard the phrase 'to wear one's heart on one's sleeve'... but what does it mean? It usually describes someone who displays their innermost feelings openly.

The expression can be traced back to the medieval days of chivalry, according to R. Brasch in That Takes the Cake. Knights who were to fight each other in a tournament wanted everyone to know for whom they fought. That's why they conspicuously wore something the lady they favored had given them as a token of her affection. Often this was a ribbon, scarf or handkerchief. The knight would then pin or tie the treasured gift to his sleeve. Hence, the saying that he wore his heart or his heart's desire on his sleeve was born.

# **Saving energy on laundry**

omewhere around 90 percent of the energy used to do laundry is used for heating the water, according to EnergySavers.gov (www.energysavers.gov). To save energy while you're washing the family clothes you can use cold water or use less water. And unless you're dealing with oily stains, the warm or cold setting on your wash-



ing machine will clean your clothes just fine. Just switching your energy setting from hot to warm can save a lot—it cuts the energy used for a load of laundry by 50 percent.

Below are some additional laundry tips from EnergySavers.gov:

- Wash your clothes in cold water and use cold water detergents whenever possible.
- Wash and dry full loads. If you do wash a smaller load, change the water-level setting.
- Dry towels and other heavier cottons separately from lighter clothing.
- Don't overdry. Use the moisture sensor on your machine if you have one.
- Clean the lint filter in your dryer after every load.
- Use the cool down cycle to allow clothes to finish drying with residual heat in the dryer.
- Check your dryer vent periodically to make sure it's not blocked. This will save energy and prevent fires.
- Dry your clothes on a clothesline or drying rack.



## **Identity Theft**

### Warning signs of identity theft

- · Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- · Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

### How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The **Federal Trade Commission** (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

### How to protect yourself from identity theft

- **Do not answer phone calls**, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or **people you do not know**.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network

## **Imposter Scam**

### The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- $\mbox{IRS}$  imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.
