




January 1, 1863: President Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation, declaring all slaves in Confederate states to be free1.



January 6, 1066: Harold Godwinson was crowned King of England. He was the last Anglo-Saxon king before the Norman Conquest1.

January 10, 1920: The League of Nations was established as the first international organization aimed at maintaining world peace1.

January 15, 1559: Elizabeth I was crowned Queen of England, marking the beginning of a reign that would become known as the Elizabethan Era1.

January 16, 1986: A bronze bust of Martin Luther King Jr. was unveiled in the Capitol Rotunda in Washington, D.C., the first statue of an African American in the building 1.

January 20, 2009: Barack Obama was inaugurated as the 44th President of the United States, becoming the first African American to hold the office1.

January 24, 1965: Winston Churchill, the former British Prime Minister, passed away at the age of 901.

January 26, 1788: Captain Arthur Phillip and the First Fleet arrived at Port Jackson, establishing the colony of New South Wales, now known as Australia1.

January 27, 1926: Scottish inventor John Logie Baird demonstrated the first working television system to the Royal Institution in London1.

Unique Foods




