





Remember after Milton when we got our electricity back, but no internet for a few days? I borrowed a couple of books. They were immediately available on my phone and replaced to viewing. One trip to the library and you never have to go there again.

My brother took an elevator to the tenth floor, and as he got out the operator said, "Have a good day, son." "Don't call me son. You're not my Dad." The operator looked puzzled and said, "No, but I did bring you up."

Once again, because my current life is so boring, we are going...

Back in the day: I got married in November 1966, and early in 1967 my husband was shipped to Germany. I followed a couple weeks later. He was stationed on a small – very small – missile base. No housing, no PX, no amenities. They had a barracks, a mess hall with a pull-down screen to play occasional movies and a counter with shelves where you could buy a candy bar or soda (that was our PX). And there were loaded missile silos in holes in the ground. With a bit of luck, my husband found an apartment for us.

I will be forever grateful for all the memorable adventures we had and glad we didn't go to a big base with on base housing and amenities. We made lifelong friends off base and learned the history and traditions of the area. There are lots of stories I could tell, including how we traveled Europe for 30 days using advice from the Frommer "Europe on \$5 a day" travel guide (it actually worked, with a \$10 daily budget between us we got rooms, meals and

entertainment), but memories of our German Christmas are in my mind today. On December 6, Germans celebrate St. Nicholas Day and if you've been good, you may get a dish with oranges, nuts, cookies and candy at your door. If you've been bad, you get a lump of coal.

We had our best Christmas tree ever. We had no lights or ornaments, so we used our pitiful imaginations. I made tiny little cardboard boxes, wrapped them and put them on the tree. We strung popcorn we colored with sprinkles of food coloring. We learned the hard way that if you put popcorn in liquid, it disintegrates so we tried sprinkling. Stringing popcorn is not fun like in the movies. It's a pain, but we persevered (we were young). Finally, we took a paper cup (back when they had the fold out handles which looked like angel wings) and topped it with a tennis ball with a magic marker face. The tree slanted way to one side from the weight of the tennis ball, but it lasted through Christmas. We've had trees big and small, bright and fancy, but none were as special as this one.

By this time, we were living with a German family, so we celebrated with them. On Christmas Eve, as we ate dinner, Ewalt, the Dad, snuck out of the kitchen. Soon after, we heard the tinkle of a bell. This was a small silver bell handed down from father to son to be used once a year. That sound signaled the Christ child had come. Everyone ran to the living room to see the beauty of the holiday. The tree was now illuminated by candles – real candles – and small gifts lay under the tree. Nobody dove for a present. We stood and joyously sang Silent Night. Afterwards presents were opened and thank you's given for gifts of socks, underwear and clothing, no toys or sporting equipment. On Christmas Day, we went to church in an ancient stone church. Multiple trees inside were lit with candles. I still don't know how the buildings didn't burn down, but it was so much more beautiful than colored lights.

I often think about that special Christmas and its simple beauty.

Now for some nonsense with no value and no meaning!

A cat died and went to Heaven. God met her at the pearly gates. He pet her and said, "You've been a good cat your whole life. Anything you want is yours for the asking." go over the edge,



We normally meet at Willard's Tap House,


