





, Gene Arend, as a member of the board of directors do not use the social media Facebook group known as Briar Creek Experience. I personally found the Briar Creek Experience / aka BCE, at times,



to be demeaning or shaming. I think the Facebook media can be a source allowing some to make statements or comments that may or may not contain true statements. For messages or information I need to communicate to the owners of the Briar Creek I Association as a Director, I use the Email service provided by the association website. These emails are sent to owners only. I have been told by secondhand sources that email messages intended for owners have been copied or echoed onto social media. The social media audience can include others than owners and the message may not be intended for others than owners.

As a director, I must be certificated under Florida Section 718.112(2)(D) 4.B. Placing condo owner information on social media can have both benefits and drawbacks. While it can enhance communications and community building, it also raises legal concerns about privacy, misinformation, and accessibility issues which can violate Florida law governing condo associations. Condo association directors have social media risks and need to take proactive steps to mitigate them. Placing condo owner information on social media is not accessible to unit owners, in Florida, according to the Condominium Act. Many social media laws have been enacted by Florida on January 1, 2025.

For these reasons any future communication being sent by email, intended for owners only, I see the need to be more restrictive or even omit some information. While I cannot prevent email communications intended for owners only to be rebroadcasted on social media, I do need to be aware of legal concerns and lawsuits which could arise from a message being rebroadcasted on social media.





Holistic Well Being

Then we observe the body, mind, and spirit holistically, or as a whole interconnected, we begin to see the importance of healthy strategies in our lives. Most of us have been raised in an allopathic model of medicine. That means we see a different doctor



for each part of our body. We have medical doctors who specialize, treating the body all too often as if the parts are not connected to the whole. As we have all experienced we may see a heart specialist who refers to an orthopedic then to an allergy doctor who recommends a gastrointestinal specialist. So often we could be seeing so many doctors who are all prescribing medication to treat symptoms that can be occurring from other prescribed medication. All of this begins when we are children being told to take medicine for every childhood issue without ever addressing what might be Causing the problem. A holistic mindset begins when we begin asking what may be causing these symptoms or illness from a physical, nutritional, or emotional perspective. As we become more informed then we have informed questions to ask any doctor we see.

This is our Real Health Insurance. It does not diminish the need for medication, or medical evaluations and or surgery when necessary, but suggests we take an active role in addressing the cause of various symptoms that can lead to serious disease. When is the last time you visited a doctor who asked you to write down what you eat and drink for a week so that it could be reviewed and evaluated. How about the last time a doctor said to write down the physical exercise you do for a week as well as what your strategies were to emotionally and mentally relax. Unless you have been to a holistic type practitioner who could be a medical doctor, chiropractor, acupuncturist, or other health care therapists, probably never.

Sadly sickness is very prevalent as well as a huge money making business. I can remember never ever seeing drug commercials on television. Now every other advertisement is promoting medication in the same way that Coke and Pepsi has prospered through the years selling us Sugar water with chemicals.

All of us want to feel better, be healthy, have the energy to participate in the things we love, yet confusingly for many go about it as if it was the least important aspect of our life. Too often we just want to take something to suppress issues, yet not change anything in our behaviors and unhealthy habits.

Something to remember. Function is measurable feeling is not. We can and easily do adapt to the loss of function while feeling OK with the load of medication we take. An example why we measure range of motion and posture and take our blood pressure, rather then using how we feel as the benchmark.

- 1. Do you think you eat healthy each day? Not necessarily perfect but healthy carbohydrates, proteins, and fats
- 2. Do you have strategies to physically exercise each day even when it's raining outside?
- 3. What healthy ways do you make the time to mentally and emotionally relax?
- 4. What are activities you would love to be able to do till 90 and above.

There is no greater wealth then our own health!


