



e would like to say goodbye to the original Board Members: Ron Howe, Suzanne Bourdeau, Brad Kalway and also Sam Vavala who stepped down late last year for personal reasons and Randy Johnson who is finishing out a 1-year term. The original HOA Board was elected in 2023 and had set 5 main objectives for us to reach during our term in office:

- 1. Represent residents who were owners at point of sale and had or had not signed new leases with Legacy. For 2023 we were able to convince Legacy to apply the 3% rent increases to all, but in 2024 Legacy standardized the base rate at \$775.00 for those without the 3% guarantee, which is still much much lower than market rent price charged to new owners.
- 2. Organize a strong HOA financial structure in order to be able to manage both the Resident Activity fund and the Transportation fund. Starting from scratch without even a bank account, two years later a robust financial structure is now in place and both funds are being accessed for the benefit of all.
- 3. Consult with residents regrading Capital Improvements wanted and submit these ideas to Legacy and then monitor progress. During the first year all resident social/activity groups were consulted, the ideas were submitted, and projects started but were then interrupted by the internal restructuring of Legacy and then two major Hurricanes. The projects are back on track for 2025.
- 4. Establish transparent communication with all residents. A functioning website now provides up to date information to all. www.rv-hoa.com
- 5. By-law revisions were tabled for discussion and approval by members last month.







VETERAN PROFILE – MARK CASE

his article appeared in our June, 2024 bulletin. Mark lost his battle with pancreatic cancer on December 29th. We thought you might like to read about this lovely man again.

On May 14th, our VFW Post 7938 welcomed in new officers, and Mark Case was installed as the Commander. This is his second time as Commander. Prior to this term, he was the Sr. Vice Commander.

Born in Fayetteville, Tennessee, in 1971, Mark says the small town offered few opportunities, resulting in a tradition of its youth going into the



military. And because he comes from a military family; his father was in the Navy and his uncle served in Vietnam; it was natural for Mark to enlist. Following in his brother's footsteps, he joined the Marines and served in Desert Storm/Desert Shield.

He was stationed mainly in Kaneohe on Oahu, and Pearl Harbor, where he trained as a diesel engine mechanic. This led to a commission on the USNS Lummus, off Bahrain, where he repaired all kinds of military equipment.

Mark credits his grandparents for being great mentors, and his grandfather for teaching him woodworking, his favorite hobby. He married his lovely wife, Melissa, in 1993 in North Shore, Oahu. They moved to Ranchero Village in 2015.

I normally ask our veterans what they attribute to their longevity, but Mark is 53; 30-40 years younger than many of our older veterans. However, Mark shares that he's a pancreatic cancer survivor and recommends if you aren't feeling well, or something hurts, get it checked out, the sooner, the better. And keep going back until they find out what's really wrong.

When asked what advice he'd give to the youth today, he says to always remember where you come from, don't forget your roots. Get involved in your community, and activities other than computers and TV. Talk to each other and tell stories around a bonfire. You never know what someone else is going through. Remember we are all equal. And always forgive.




