COTTAGE CHEESE SPINACH TART

9-inch pie shell, baked 1/3 c. minced onion

2 Tbsp butter 1/2 c. cooked, well squeezed chopped spinach

1/4 c. milk 4 eggs

1 - 1/2 c creamed cottage cheese 1/2 c. Parmesan cheese

2 tomatoes, sliced and cut in half 1 Tbsp butter

In skillet, cook onion in butter over moderate heat, stirring for 2 minutes. Add spinach and cook, stirring for 2 minutes. Remove skillet from heat, stir in milk, and let mixture cool. In bowl, beat together eggs, cottage cheese, and Parmesan cheese. Stir in spinach mixture. Pour mixture into pie shell, arrange tomato slices decoratively over it, and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Dot filling with butter. Bake @ 350 for 35 to 40 minutes, or until knife inserted in center comes out clean. Let tart cool for 10 minutes before serving.

ICE CREAM STRAWBERRY DESSERT

10 oz. Pkg. Frozen strawberries in syrup, thawed
1 pint vanilla ice cream
4 dessert shells
Whole strawberries

In blender, puree strawberries (you can use fresh strawberries if they are in season). Spread 1/4 c. puree on bottom of a dessert plate. Place shell in center of each plate. Fill shells with scoop of ice cream. Top with additional puree. Garnish with whole berries.


