Using format to inspire funny writing

Teed to write something funny for the company newsletter? Why not trying using a humorous format, suggests humor writer Tim Bete, director of University of Dayton's Erma Bombeck Writers' Workshop. Bete's work has been published in the Christian Science Monitor and more than a dozen parenting magazines. He is also the author of In The Beginning...There Were No Diapers.

Bete says there are three parts to humor pieces: the topic, the format and the individual jokes. Formats help tie pieces together and make them coherent, Bete says. Don't wait for the world's funniest idea to strike you before you start writing, he says. Starting with structure and letting the humor come through is much more effective. Here are a few of the formats he recommends to get you writing.

- **1. The Diary Format.** This format gives you a chronological structure to build on. "Day 1: Day 2; etc.
- **2.** The Advice Format. This parodies the "Dear Abby" style.
- **3.** The How-Not-To-Format. This might be in the vein of how to buy the worst birthday present in the world, etc.
- **4. Parody interview format.** An interview, for example, of the mother who always buys the worst Christmas presents every year.
- **5. Quiz Format.** This might be a quiz that helps you determine whether you've picked the world's worst Valentine's Day gift or not.

Using formats, Bete says, often generates ideas that don't fit neatly into the template. But who cares — you're writing, and that's what counts.
