



Tow, just check out our March calendar. So many wonderful things to attend. Make sure you keep your Voice calendar in a handy spot, so you do not miss all the fun.

Many of you do not have access to FYI Lincolnshire. I wanted to share the photo below of one of our bulk trash containers prior to the City of Largo picking it up back in early February, shared by our Property Manager. Please be mindful we pay for our garbage costs every month. Like many businesses Rickert Properties looks back on all of their annual expenses prior to calculating our annual rent increases. Garbage cost is one of them. There are normal increases the City of Largo passes along on an annual basis that cannot be controlled. We can control some of the additional costs incurred if we stop overfilling the bulk trash and recycling containers and stop fines from the City of Largo every month. Putting these fines on top of any normal garbage charges will increase our total annual costs dramatically in 2025.

Many of us hire outside vendors to do work in our homes. We should be checking to make sure that part of the cost that we are charged should include vendors discarding major construction items at the County dump not in our community monthly bulk trash. I have witnessed Tuesday mornings when the bulk trash bin is dropped off empty only to be filled within the first two hours it is on site. We all need to do better by keeping the bulk trash container and re-cycling bins from becoming over filled.


ANNUAL BAZAAR UPDATE

COMPACTOR REMINDER

friendly reminder for all our residents. Whenever you take trash to the compactor, please remember to close the door after depositing your garbage. **DO NOT PRESS THE RED BUTTON**. This compactor is pre-programmed to automatically start compaction after the door has been closed three (3) times. It is very important that the compactor door is **CLOSED after you deposit your garbage**. Do not throw large items into the compactor. You will need to wait till the bulk trash container is brought into the community each month. See Voice calendar for dates dumpster is scheduled each month.

Don't forget to break down your cardboard boxes before throwing them in the mixed recycle bins. If the recycling bins are full do not overfill them, the lids should be able to lay flat. Put your recycled items in the compactor instead. When the city comes to take the recycling bins all the "over" loaded trash ends up on our streets. Please! Please! Think before you overload those containers.





- ❖ Tips on safe and successful community living in Lincolnshire Estates:

ad that a man who has dedicated his life to the service of our country would be treated like this. President Donald Trump focused his ire and retaliation on one person in the very first minutes of his presidency, even before his inauguration concluded -- retired Army Gen. Mark Milley, the highest-ranking and most visible officer in the military during the president's first term in office. On Jan. 20, as Trump was sworn in, Milley's recently unveiled portrait painting from his time as Joint Chiefs chairperson was quietly removed from a hallway in the Pentagon that displays portraits of all former chairpersons. A week later, another portrait of Milley, a retired Green Beret with more than 40 years of service, from his time as Army chief of staff was removed. The humiliation was not over for Milley. Trump's newly appointed defense secretary, Pete Hegseth, announced he was ending Milley's security detail and initiating an investigation into the retired general to see whether they could strip him of rank, removing one of his stars in retirement. This would cost him and his family thousands!

But the final blow for Milley might be the silence after the open retaliation by Trump, who campaigned on punishing his political enemies. Few have come to Milley's defense and even the military, to which the four-star general had given decades of service, was unwilling to offer any pushback. One recently retired general noted to Military.com that Milley is "as radioactive as it gets." Military.com reached out to a dozen current and retired general officers for comment on the actions the Trump administration has taken against Milley. None would speak even under the condition their names be withheld from publication to protect them from retaliation, a common practice in the press to allow officials to speak candidly when their views could draw retribution. Keeping Milley at a distance, even anonymously, showed the widespread concern that Trump and his allies pose a threat to those who may fall out of step. While removing a portrait may seem like a trivial matter, the Pentagon is not just office space -- its miles of hallways are also living memorials of military history and heritage. Aside from each service dedicating hallways to their accomplishments and history, memorialized within the Pentagon are hundreds of leaders, heroes and battles that stretch back to the founding of the nation or the creation of the services. There are portraits of the secretaries of war, historical artifacts, and even dioramas so elaborate that one incorporates two Vietnam-era Huey helicopter cabs. Among those displays are hallways lined with portraits of every chairperson of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and, for the Army, a hallway with every chief of staff. Both hallways now have gaps where Milley's portrait hung -- his service scrubbed from the living timeline of the Defense Department's headquarters. One editorial published Thursday called the move a "Soviet-style" purge.

This is certainly a sad day for the History of the Military and our Country! This certainly should send a message to all officers of the Military, pledge your loyalty to the King or Perish!

incolnshire Estates is an over 55 age lot rental park, not an assisted living or senior park. Increasing number of homeowners are working or volunteering daily including weekends too. Inside and outside the park. I lead into this article knowing that there are residents who are genuine seniors well over 65, homeowners who have senior family members back home, close, or far away. Plus, those not close to retirement who struggle with serious, life ending medical or mentally compromising conditions. I am writing

Closing out our life or those of our loved ones is hard, extremely hard. Often not a very delicate journey with few alternatives to choose from. Doing everything possible in an American health system appears often to be the normal course. However, being aware of other caring and loving trails of care must be part of the discussion. I offer some noted myths that are often barriers to a higher level of love and caring. Please read on.

The foundation of the article is on Hospice and Palliative Care. Both of my parents benefitted from this outstanding level of care. Certainly, noticed by their 2 sons.

I will cover the first 3 myths of Hospice and Palliative Care. The April edition will conclude with the others. It is not easy by any means to read with pleasure. Please do not dismiss.

The first myth is those who have cancer are the only beneficiaries of this Medicare benefit.
When it was first created, hospice care was primarily for cancer patients. Today, while many hospice patients do have cancer, the majority have other life-limiting diseases, such as Alzheimer's disease, cardiovascular disease and dementia, failure in wanting to live anymore.

✓ Eligibility for hospice care requires that two physicians agree that the person's illness state gives them a prognosis of six months or less to live, that does not mean that they must die within six months. Our former President, Jimmy Carter lived a year in Hospice. This added longevity happens every day.

The second myth is that you must have just a few weeks or days to live. Hospice care is as much about how you want to live as it is about how you want to die. Instead of focusing on curing an illness or prolonging death, the goal of care becomes to relieve symptoms and give patients the best quality of life they can have in their remaining days. And they want to have the best quality of life that they can.

The third myth is that hospice is place that all must go to and receive care.

✓ Hospice is rarely an actual location that people go to. The care wants to provide care where a person lives. Hospice tries going where the patients' lives if reasonable, safe, and possible.

✓ Patients want to die at home, but home hospice care can be tough on families. The 3 C's: Caring, Caretaking and Caregiving.

Lastly, Hospice patients are assigned to a team of providers: a physician, registered nurse, home health aide, social worker, and chaplain at a minimum. They work together to a "w" holistic level of support. A bit more in April.
