ATTENTION RESIDENTS!



Pea Soup and Beer Biscuits - Happy St. Patrick's Day

In Solvang, California, Anderson Split Pea Soup Company is known for its Pea Soup - some of the best I've ever tasted. The recipe below duplicates or comes close to duplicating their recipe. Perfect for St. Patrick's Day - I suppose you could add a little green food coloring if you want to.

DUTCH PEA SOUP

1 c. green split peas
1 tsp. salt
2 potatoes
1 small piece of pork on bone
2 leeks (white part only)

2 stalks of celery with leaves 1 small celery root, chopped

1 medium onion, chopped 1/2 c. finely chopped bacon

1 chicken bouillon cube mixed with 1/4 c. hot water

Rinse peas thoroughly, cover them with water, and soak overnight. Simmer peas in water in which they soaked for 1 hour. Add all ingredients except bouillon and cook for 1 hour or until vegetables are very soft and meat is tender. Remove the pork, shred the meat, and discard the bone, and set aside. Puree the vegetables and bacon in food processor or blender. Return to pan along with the pork and cook for 30 min. or until thick. Add chicken bouillon.

BEER BISCUITS

4 c. buttermilk baking mix 2 Tbsp. sugar 12 oz. beer

1 Mix ingredients; spoon into greased muffin tins. Bake at 350 for 10 - 15 min. or until brown.
