April Birthstone

April Birthstones

ur love for the April birthstone started in India, where diamonds were gathered from the country's rivers and streams. Traded as early as the fourth century BCE, diamonds were coveted by royalty and the wealthy. Later, caravans brought Indian diamonds, along with other exotic merchandise, to medieval markets in Venice. By the 1400s, diamonds were becoming fashionable accessories for Europe's elite. The first diamond engagement ring on record was given by Archduke Maximillian of Austria to his betrothed, Mary of Burgundy, in 1477. Recent evidence supports the origin of the legendary 45.52 carat (ct) blue Hope diamond in India's Golconda mining area and its sale to King Louis XIV of France (then known as the French Blue diamond) in 1668.

In the early 1700s, as India's diamond supplies began to decline, Brazil emerged as an important source. Diamonds were discovered when gold miners sifted through gravels on the banks of the Jequitinhonha River in Minas Gerais. Brazil dominated the diamond market for more than 150 years.




April & Fun Facts & Recipes

It's true that **spring** officially starts on the Spring Equinox in **March** (and believe us, we're not snubbing that extra hour of daylight that arrives with it), but let's be real—April is when it feels like spring really begins, right? As we shed our coats, we also start to change over our **dinner** habits, swapping heavy dishes for lighter ones (but don't worry, we're not giving up the pastas and creamy chicken dishes just yet)—join us! We've got 40 recipes to help inspire you to make dinner this April—one for every day of the month, and then some.

One of our favorite parts of spring is all the fresh produce that becomes available, like **strawberries**, **asparagus**, and **mushrooms**. We've included a good mix of entirely new recipes featuring the bounty, like our **one-pan crispy chicken primavera**, our **halal-cart style cauliflower bowls**, and our **blackberry chicken salad**, as well as some old classics, like our **pasta primavera**, our **chicken-parm stuffed peppers**, and our **chicken, spinach, & artichoke lasagna**. Use them all as jumping off points, and sub in whatever you can find at your local farmers' market.

Chicken Primavera

hicken primavera is spring on a plate! When temperatures start to rise and the first seasonal vegetables show up at the market, it's the perfect way to celebrate their fresh flavors. So if you find yourself craving them, along with **pasta** and **chicken**, you're in luck—this speedy, one-pot recipe delivers on all of it.

Ingredients

- 2 boneless skinless chicken breasts (1 1/4 to 1 1/2 lb.) lb.) cut into 1-inch cubes
- 2 1/2 tsp. salt, divided
- 2 tsp. ground black pepper, plus more for garnish
- 4 Tbsp. butter, divided
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 16 oz. dried short pasta, such as penne, rotini, or cavatappi
- 1 32-oz. container chicken broth
- 3 carrots, thinly sliced (about 2 cups)
- 2 cups asparagus pieces, about 1-inch long, from 1 bunch (woody stems removed)
- 1 1/2 cups fresh or frozen peas
- 2 cups cherry tomatoes, halved
- 6 garlic cloves, grated
- 1 1/2 cups freshly grated parmesan cheese
- 1 lemon, zested then cut in half
- 1/2 cup chopped fresh basil, plus more for garnish

Directions

- 1. Season the chicken with 1 1/2 teaspoons of the salt and 1 teaspoon of the pepper. Add 2 tablespoons of the butter and all of the olive oil to a large Dutch oven; heat over medium-high heat.
- 2. Add the seasoned chicken to the pan. Cook, stirring occasionally, until the chicken is lightly browned all over, about 5 minutes. Use a slotted spoon to transfer the chicken from the pan onto a plate and set aside.
- 3. Add the pasta to the pan; stir to coat it in the oil mixture. Add the broth and 2 cups of water, and bring to a simmer. Reduce heat to medium or medium low to keep it simmering for 6 minutes, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking.
- 4. Stir in the carrots, asparagus, and peas. Cover the pot, and let cook until the pasta and vegetables are just tender, about 4 minutes.
- 5. Uncover the pot. Add the tomatoes, grated garlic, and cooked chicken to the pan. Cook, stirring occasionally, for about 2 minutes to reheat the chicken.
- 6. Remove from the heat and add the remaining 2 tablespoons butter, parmesan cheese, lemon zest and juice, and the remaining 1 teaspoon each of the salt and pepper; stir to combine.
- 7. Stir in the basil just before serving. Top each serving with more parmesan and basil, if you like.


