dvice from an attorney

- 1. IF YOU DO NOTHING ELSE, put a beneficiary on all of your financial accounts like checking savings CDs, Life Insurance, investments etc. You don't need a will for them to get to your money, just a death certificate. And make a list, preferably by hand instead of your computer, either give it to your trusted person, spouse or put it in your security box at the bank. If the person doesn't know you have a savings account or a CD at XYZ Bank, they can never go get the money. Make sure you have a trusted person that is a signer on the security box at the bank. IMPORTANT information to get your affairs in order!! Make sure all bank accounts have direct beneficiaries. The beneficiary need only go to the bank with your death certificate and an ID of their own.
- 2. TOD = Transfer On Death deed if you own a home. Completing this document and filing it with your county saves your heirs THOUSANDS. This document allows you to transfer ownership of your home to your designee. All they need to do is take their ID and your death certificate to the county building and the deed is signed over. Doing this will avoid the home having to go through probate.
- 3. Living Will: Allows one to put in writing exactly what you want done in the event you cannot speak for yourself when it comes to healthcare decisions as well as other final decisions.
- 4. Durable Power of Attorney: Allows one to designate a person to make legal decisions if you are no longer competent to do so. Power of Attorney for Healthcare: This document allows one to designate someone to make healthcare decisions for them.
- 5. Last Will and Testament: Designates to whom personal belongings will go to, who the Administrator will be. But if you have a beneficiary on any of your financial accounts, that will override a will. For instance if you say I leave all of my possessions to my daughter Susie, but on your savings account the beneficiary is your best friend, then the money goes to your best friend
- 6. Funeral Planning Declaration: Allows one to say exactly one's wishes as far as disposition of the body and the services.

If the above documents are done, you can AVOID probate. If all the above is not done, you have to open an estate account at the bank. All money that doesn't have direct beneficiaries goes into this account. You have to have an attorney to open the estate account. The attorney also has to publicize your passing in the newspaper or post publication at the county courthouse,

to allow anyone to make a claim on your property. - It's a complete PAIN. Make a list of all banks and account numbers, all investment institutions with account numbers, lists of credit cards, utility accounts, etc. Leave clear instructions as to how and when these things are paid. Make sure heirs know where life insurance policies are located. Make 100% sure SOMEONE knows your Apple ID, bank ID account logins and passwords! Make sure you have titles for all vehicles, campers, etc! Set up a TRUST for intended beneficiaries, especially those that are too young, and appoint a trustee of said trust. MOST IMPORTANTLY!!!! - Talk with those closest to you and make all your wishes KNOWN. Talk to those whom you've designated, as well as those close to you whom you did not designate. - Do this to explain why your decisions were made and to avoid any lingering questions or hurt feelings. Hope this helps! Hope this lights a spark to encourage all your friends and family to take care of these things to make it easier for those we all leave behind! My hope is that the above list at least helps you start an important conversation with your loved ones...

Seasonal allergies

pring allergies in Florida are common and can include tree pollen, grass pollen, and weed pollen. The warm, humid climate allows plants to release pollen nearly year-round. The worst months for allergies in Florida are April, May, and September. These months have the highest pollen counts.

Why are these months so bad?

• Warm, rainy climate

Florida's climate supports year-round plant growth, which leads to a long pollen season.

• Different plants pollinate

Many different plants pollinate throughout the year, including trees, weeds, and grasses. What allergens are common in Florida?

- Oak pollen: Most problematic in late winter and early spring
- Mold spores: Thrive in the humid summer months
- Ragweed: A prominent allergen in the fall
- Dog fennel: A weed that causes allergies from May through December
- Sorrel and dock: A secondary weed pollen season from March through July Symptoms

Runny nose, Coughing, Congestion, Sneezing, Headaches, Scratchy throat, Itchy eyes, Watery eyes, Hives, and Asthma symptoms.

Tips to reduce allergies

- Avoid spending extended periods outdoors during peak pollen times
- Shower after spending time outdoors
- Keep doors and windows closed
- Vacuum often
- Use a nasal rise to move allergens out of your nasal passages
- Protect your home with HEPA filters
- Check local pollen counts regularly
- Plan yard work around pollen spikes

Balance and stability

Tere is a wide variety of exercises and tips to improve balance, including heel-toe walks, standing on one leg, and heel-raise squats. You should also be sure you are getting enough sleep, it helps to maintain balance as well.

Exercises

- Heel-toe walk: Stand next to a wall and walk heel to toe, then turn around and walk back
- One-legged stand: Stand on one foot for at least five seconds
- Tandem stand: Put the heel of one foot on the toe of the other foot and hold for more than 10 seconds
- Toe tap: Stand with one hand on a wall and lift one leg out in front of you, then touch your toes to the ground
- Heel-raise squat: Squat down, then stand back up, lifting your heels off the floor as far as you can

Other tips

- Work on standing with your feet shoulder-width apart and eyes open
- Try closing your eyes while balancing to increase the challenge
- Get enough sleep

Balance can decline with age due to vision loss, muscle weakness, and inner ear issues. Certain medications can also affect balance. A rehabilitation program can help people make significant improvements.

Romance Scams

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can
 use details shared on social media and dating sites to better
 understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- · Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone.
