






The next Koffee Klatch will be Saturday, April 19th and will feature a special presentation. Come enjoy a cup of coffee and a donut and stay for a special presentation by Fairway Village's resident Paralympian Kim Seevers. Kim's presentation to the group last spring was very well received and she'll be returning, this time with a very special guest.

Please sign up for this event by April 16th in the Clubhouse.

The 2026 Winter Olympics and Paralympics will be held next February in Milan-Cortina, Italy. Athletes from Team USA have been training for the past three years for their opportunity to represent their country in Cortina next winter. Kim will take us on a visual journey behind the scenes of the Winter Games from an athlete's perspective with glimpses of training leading up to selection to Team USA, life in the athlete's village, traditions that the public doesn't see, and of course, the pageantry of the Opening Ceremony through the athlete's eyes. This time around, Kim will be joined by Para Bobsled athlete Will Castillo. Will served in the Army and was severely injured when the vehicle he and his men were riding in was destroyed by an IED. Will was the only survivor. After several years of self-sabotage, and his attendance at a para-bobsled camp as a beginner, Will dedicated himself to earning a spot on Team USA and competing on the World Cup Para Bobsleigh circuit. In 2023 Will finished the World Cup season as the overall points leader and won the coveted golden globe, awarded to the overall World Champion. You won't want to miss it as Will shares the story of his journey from rock bottom to the top of the international Para Bobsled world.

The Olympic Games are almost here. No, not the ones in Italy next winter; we're talking about the 2025 Fairway Village Olympics and they're just seven weeks away!

Rumor has it some districts began practicing right after the Closing Ceremony last year! The key to success will be for your district to enter participants in every event.






This season, which was different in many ways worked out pretty well. With the new generations moving into Fairway we have experienced great interest in volunteerism – thank you.

SCAM ! ALERT Romance Scams

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone. ReportFraud.ftc.gov
