







By this time, our Snowbird neighbors have mostly returned to their Northern homes. Our hopes are that you all have a wonderful summer and will rejoin us in the fall. 
Because many residents will be leaving for the summer, any future requests that come in will be reviewed but not presented at the meeting until the fall when the business meetings resume.

### **WE AIN'T PERFECT**

don't know about you but sometimes I mess up. In reflection it let's me see myself where I can still be better. Let me give you an example. Almost every day I am either on the Tennis court or Pickleball court. I have been a competitive athlete my entire life. Sometimes in the heat of a game and the Florida heat I may say something to my partner. The collection includes hardbacks, paperbacks, a small but growing collection of large print books, a Christmas collection and some biographies.

As clubhouse librarians, we reshelf the returned books and check for duplicates and condition, as books do age and eventually fall apart, maybe a cup of coffee is spilled on them or a dog chews a few pages, puzzle pieces go missing and DVDs no longer play properly. We don't reshelve these items and only keep the copy in the best condition when we find duplicates.

New books come from those residents who like to share a good book they have just finished, and often when a house is sold and either the seller no longer wants all the books they have or the buyer of a fully furnished house has different tastes, these books are donated to the library.

As the shelves become too crowded, we remove books that have not been borrowed for a few years. We take these to the East Lake Library which has a great program for sorting and providing new homes for old books. In the last several years some 5,000 books and puzzles from our library have been donated to East Lake.

Our books are date stamped and we mark all the returns so that we can identify books that have not been borrowed. For that reason we ask you to put all the books you are returning into the basket rather than reshelving them yourself.

The library has a selection of books, puzzles and DVDs that is constantly being monitored and which changes over time. There is no requirement for library cards, no formal checkout, no fines for a book you forget to return, convenient hours (whenever the clubhouse is open), and even a step stool to give access to the books on top shelves.

We always appreciate donations of books, puzzles and DVDs you no longer want, with the exception of books for children, foreign language editions. coffee table volumes, cook books, travel guides, textbooks, religious and personal health and wellness guides as the library shelf space is limited. If you are looking for a new home for these kinds of books, we can offer some suggestions.


