





MO FOR YOU AND ME: FMO NEEDS YOU:

House Bill 701 has been presented to committee and voted on passing 16 to 0. It is now presented to the Senate as SB 1714. Major point of this Bill is to Amend Chapter 420, Part VII of Florida Law to assist eligible mobile home owners who own their homes that are placed on leased land with lot rent payments. Assistance to be based on the home owner's financial need, specifically low and moderate income. Program to assist persons whose annual incomes are not more than 140 per cent of the area median income. Eligible home owner will apply to the county or eligible municipality to participate in the Local Housing Assistance Plan to assist with lot rent payments specifically. Owners be required to provide financial records to confirm eligibility.

AT THE TIME OF THIS ARTICLE, IT HAS NOT BEEN PRESENTED, PASSED, NOT SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR.

The FMO supports mobile home owners' concerns about lot rent increases and eliminate the discrimination that exists against mobile home owners within the conversation of affordable housing. This is the first submission of a bill to the legislature. Opposition is expected and if rejected it will be presented in the next session.




