





he end of May, more specifically, Memorial Day, signals the beginning of summer. Many people (not me) like to barbecue for the summer holidays. Here are two recipes which pair well with hamburgers, hotdogs or barbecue ribs when you decide to grill out this summer.

I SIMPLE BAKED BEANS

Ingredients

1/2 pound bacon, chopped

1 onion, finely chopped

2 (15 ounce) cans baked beans

1/4 cup brown sugar

1/4 cup ketchup

1/4 cup prepared mustard, or to taste

Directions

Step 1. Cook bacon over medium heat until evenly brown. Add the onion and sauté until tender. Drain excess oil, if desired.

Step 2. Stir in beans, brown sugar, ketchup, and mustard. Cook, stirring occasionally, until bubbly.

OLD-FASHIONED POTATO SALAD

I Ingredients

5 medium potatoes

3 large eggs

1 cup celery, chopped

1/2 cup onion, chopped

1/2 cup sweet pickle relish

1/4 cup mayonnaise

1 tablespoon mustard

1/4 teaspoon garlic salt

1/4 teaspoon celery salt

Ground pepper to taste



Directions

Step 1. Boil potatoes and cook until tender, but firm; about 15 minutes. Drain, cool, peel and chop potatoes.

Step 2. While potatoes are cooking, place eggs in a saucepan and cover with cold water. Bring water to boil; cover, remove from heat, and let eggs stand in hot water for 10 to 12 minutes. Remove eggs from hot water; cool, peel and chop.

Step 3. Combine the potatoes, eggs, celery, onion, relish, mayonnaise, mustard, garlic salt, celery salt, and pepper in a large bowl. Mix together well and refrigerate until chilled.

FROM THE OFFICE

It is hard to believe that we are already in the month of May, which means June is right around the corner; with June comes hurricane season. There is an article in this issue regarding hurricane preparedness, so I will not speak about that.

I want to remind you that the Park is not your electrical supplier, Duke Energy is. You can sign up for alerts on your phone to keep you updated on outages; calling the company multiple times a day only wastes their time in getting updated information out to all the customers (and is stupid)! If Duke Energy has no timeframe on the power returning, and Spectrum has no clue when your cable will be back on, NEITHER DO WE! I cannot stress enough about making plans to leave the park when a hurricane warning is issued. Keep in mind that over a dozen residents were without power for more than 2 months after Hurricane Milton; none of them prepared for a week, let alone a longer time. It takes 2 main items to restore power, Parts and Permits from the city....and don't forget the inspections from the city before Duke can energize the lines. It is not up to the Park to provide you with alternative places to live, other power sources, etc. Rent will not be waived, hurricanes are an "Act of God." Now is the time to look into mobile home insurance, it IS available if your home is in good repair. So far it has not been ridiculously expensive (I pay \$1440 for high coverage, including household contents and the shed with a \$1,000 deductible, and temporary living arrangements). It started at \$860 seven years ago, but what hasn't increased in price?

How many of you are in a one-person household and shop at Publix? When they have Bogos and you know you won't use both items, pick up the other one and donate it to the food events we have on the second and fourth Mondays of the month. Extra food items can be dropped off at the office. We do not need egg cartons for a while, we have a huge inventory of them, thanks for all the donations.

A reminder to all residents that 1st street is a one-way street, which is INTO the park. You should not use it as an exit; even those who live on 1st street must use 3rd street as your exit.



Third street is an EXIT only, which means do not enter the park this way. This is going to cause an accident, and the injured party may be you!

Now is the time to get your lot in clean, weeded condition. It will get really hot, real soon; if you start with a well-maintained yard and carport, it will be much easier to keep it clean when it is so hot you really don't want to be outside. Don't forget you have a backyard, which is not for storage of unwanted bikes, grills, chairs, etc. This may sound harsh, but regardless of the heat, your health or age, you are responsible for keeping your lot up to park standards. If you aren't able to do this, you are expected to get it done somehow.

I have been asked many times why one of the requirements to live here is having a minimum of 3 months rent as a monthly income. Why? So they have enough "discretionary" income to buy weed killer or pay someone to do what age no longer allows us to do ourselves. Some of you may be asking "What is discretionary income"? It is what you have left after your regular bills and obligations are paid each month. Having your mobile home power washed once a year (per park rules) is another need for this extra income; painting your mobile, replacing a broken window, etc. are more reasons. Our rent is in the lower 20% of housing cost in Pinellas County. Average monthly rent in Pinellas County for 2019 (the last year data was available for) was \$1,183.......this is not just manufactured homes; it includes all types of housing. Imagine what 5 years of inflation has done to that average? Current park rent of \$740 is only 63% of that. Just a reminder that the grass is not always greener on the other side.

Watch for the flyers, we hope to have some activities this summer (Saturday bingo, hot dog roast, ice cream social, just to name a few).

Visit the Library, without a doubt we have one of the best Libraries to be found in a manufactured home community. It offers puzzles....imagine a puzzle party where adult beverages are served!

Keep active, keep moving, enjoy the pool, enjoy your golden years.





HURRICANE SEASON

Tes, folks. It's that time again. Hurricane season runs June 1st through November 30th and the time to start preparing is now. Weather forecasters are projecting 17 named storms, with nine becoming hurricanes and four building to major hurricane strength this year. Last year, experts predicted an all-time high 11 hurricanes during the 2024 season. They were correct.



Some of you may remember that Florida offers a disaster preparedness tax holiday twice a year. The first holiday of 2025 is June 1-14, so it's time to make a checklist of items that you are going to need.

Examples of tax-free items include flashlights and lanterns costing \$40 or less; reusable ice costing \$20 or less; radios costing \$50 or less; tarps and ground anchors or tiedown kits costing \$100 or less; coolers and portable power banks costing \$60 or less; batteries and fuel tanks costing \$50 or less; smoke detectors, fire extinguishers and carbon monoxide detectors costing \$70 or less;

and generators costing \$3000 or less. The holiday also includes a number of items related to clean up after a disaster. For example, laundry detergent, toilet paper and paper towels, soap, sunscreen, and household cleaning products with a sales price of \$30 or less.

The possibility of a major hurricane striking our area is not something to be taken lightly. Those who were here when last year's Hurricane Milton struck in October can attest to the fact that we must be prepared for the worst case scenario. All of the park was without power for more than four days, and some homes didn't get full power restored until early December. An estimated 30% of the homes at Embassy Park were affected/damaged by either the hurricane itself or the accompanying high winds. Several of our streets were flooded and impassible for many days. If you have an alternate "safe space" where you can evacuate, you should plan to do so. And don't wait until the last minute to do this because roads will be clogged with evacuation traffic and airports close as soon as the leading hurricane winds make it dangerous for planes to fly.

If you have not already done so, stop by the office and pick up a copy of the Disaster Preparedness Guide. The 2025 issue has not yet come out, however, much of the guidance is the same from year to year. The Disaster Preparedness Guide contains helpful tips and checklists that you can tailor to fit your own family situation. Whether staying put or evacuating to a shelter, I highly recommend that you create your own checklist based on the examples found in the hurricane guide.

It's never too early to be prepared. And my motto is "better safe than sorry".




