



1. All renters/visitors required to register and apply for background check at the office. Show proof of age. Owners check-in and also leave departure date. Update your information.

2. Permit required for overnight parking in **designated** areas. Overnight street parking is not permitted.

Obtain permit at office (5-L) during office hours.

3. Speed Limit in park: 10 MPH. Be aware of other cars when parking on streets. They are very narrow. Emergency vehicles should be able to pass easily.

4. Check Clubhouse Activity Room # 1 for information on possible sales or rentals available.

- 5. Children must be accompanied by resident adult to use Pool & Clubhouse. All residents are to wear cover-up or Tee shirt when in clubhouse. DO NOT WALK INTO CLUBHOUSE WITH WET FEET!
- 6. SAFETY HINT: Use a FLASHLIGHT when walking during the dark hours after 6:00P. Golf Carts turn lights ON.

7. Residents should have Emergency Contact information in their office file, in case of medical problem or weather emergency.

8. Any requests for our maintenance staff is to be submitted, IN WRITING, so work order can be generated. No verbal requests, please.

Pointe West Community Organizations

1. Residents Owned Community - ROC

- a. Residents who bought a share in community which owns the land. They display a black permanent tag on their coach.
- b. These residents pay real estate taxes to Pinellas County.

c. They pay a monthly maintenance fee to the ROC.

d. Organization elects residents to the Board to govern the running of Pointe West. These (9) directors elect yearly: a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer.

2. Recreation Association - REC

- a. All residents are eligible to join, paying \$2.50 per person for life.
- b. It's managed by a Board of Directors (9) for rotating three year terms. They then elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer each year.
- c. They plan a Social calendar for winter and summer seasons.

3. Home Owners' Association - HOA

- a. Pointe West Homeowners Association Inc. A not-for profit corporation. The H.O.A. is by law, the official and legally recognized representative.
- b. Members Non-shareholders who rent their lots here regarding, rent increases, park rules and regulations, park amenities, state governing statutes.

4. Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc.

(FMO) 420 Portsmouth Rd., Largo, Florida (727)530-7539

a. Members – Florida manufactured homeowers.

b. Objectives – represents MFHO regarding state legislation And statutes in Florida.

More Weird Florida Facts

Traveling around this state this summer? Check your watch! There are two time zones in Florida -- Eastern Time (ET) and Central Time (CT). The southern and eastern parts of Florida observe Eastern Time and ten counties in the northern and western part of Florida—the Panhandle—observe Central Time.

One county in the Florida Panhandle, Gulf County, observes both Eastern Time and Central Time. The southern portion of the county, with its largest city, Port St. Joe, uses Eastern Time, while Wewahitchka in the northern portion observes Central Time.





Closing Up Your Home Checklist

Thanks to Officer Keith Bowling, Largo Police Department, for a very informative KK presentation and for providing the following checklist to help us in preparing to be away from the Park for the summer. In addition to the checklist suggestions, remember to remove outdoor furniture, decorations and anything that could become a projectile during a storm.

INSIDE

- 1. Secure valuables Use a fireproof locked safe Safety deposit box
- 2. Record and store your serial numbers
- 3. Use timers for lights
- 4. Use a security camera
- 5. Use a security system with audible alarm
- 6. Secure your windows Track locks, dowel, bar
- 7. Secure your slider Rod, pin, track lock
- 8. Lock everything Use a double cylinder deadbolt with a capture key if you have a door window

OUTSIDE

- 1. Secure all valuables such as bikes inside
- 2. Trim all landscaping to 2 foot/6 foot rule
- 3. Make good visibility so neighbors can see your home
- 4. Use good lighting Dawn to dusk, motion, use LED lighting
- 5. Don't rope off your driveway
- 6. Let a friend park in your driveway
- 7. Don't cover your car
- 8. Have a friend wash your car
- 9. Make a friend to look out for your place!

"The Twist" Dance Craze Started Here As the story goes, Hank Ballard, the man who wrote the song Chubby Checker turned into a smash hit, was inspired by seeing African American teenagers dancing on Central Avenue during its heyday in the 1950s. "The Twist" was the B-side of its record, but quickly became a national sensation when Checker performed it on "American Bandstand." And a dance craze was born. <u>Pre-fabricated Housing Started In Ybor City</u> Ever the efficiency expert, Vicente Martinez Ybor needed a quick way to house the throngs of cigar workers pouring into Tampa Bay. He ordered small, simple homes (casitas) that could arrive by train partially built and be assembled in about a week. Workers had the monthly mortgage deducted directly from their pay. You can still see some of the original casitas when you visit the Ybor City Museum State Park.

ot your library card? The Pinellas Public Library Cooperative has partnered with area museums to offer free family admission to the following museums:

How the museum pass works:

- Each PPLC member library has museum passes for each museum partner.
- Passes are available for in-person check-out on a first-come, first-served basis. Passes are not renewable or holdable.
- Availability of passes can be searched in the PPLC online catalog or by contacting the library's circulation staff.
- You may check out passes for more than one museum, but you may only have one pass per museum at a time.
- Passes can only be checked out by adult PPLC cardholders in good standing.
- Upon check out of a pass, the cardholder will receive a check-out receipt, which must be taken to the museum.
- The library check-out receipt must be presented to museum staff upon entry. The museum will retain the receipt.
- Admission is valid for up to 2 adults and 3 children, under the age of 18, from the same household.
- Each pass is valid for one visit within the 7-day loan period. Passes are checked out for a full 7-day period.
- Passes will automatically be removed from a borrower's record after 7 days. There are no overdue fines or lost charges on passes.
- Passes are not available to reciprocal borrowers.

In Park Friendly Shuffle: whether it's your first time or you've been playing for years! Friendly Shuffle happens every Monday and Friday at 1:00 pm.







ffice Hours: Regular office hours are Monday through Friday from 9am to 1pm. If you wish to come to the office outside these hours please call to make an appointment (727) 584-8924.

Gate Fobs: Fobs (like a garage door opener) for the gate between Pointe West and Four Seasons are available for purchase at the Pointe West Office during regular business hours. The cost is \$31.00 each, cash only, no checks. If you do not buy a fob for the gate, the manual code will still work.

<u>NOTE CHANGES TO</u> Water Restrictions: Pointe West's designated days for watering are Wednesday or Sunday, before 10am and after 4pm. Please adjust your watering schedule accordingly or you may receive a violation notice and be subject to fines. Residents are reminded that leaving the water on when hose is not in use, even if the spray nozzle is closed, is in violation of county regulations. Please ensure that all water is turned off when hoses are not in use. For more information, see https://pinellas.gov/watering-schedule-and-rules/.
