From the Board of Directors Roland Doucette, President

Tith the summer heat upon us, it is important that as we go to the pool to get a little relief from the heat, we comply with the rules that allow us to keep our pool open. These rules are in your Blue



Book, and also posted at the pool. You should take a few minutes to review them before your guests arrive. Of the rules that are there, the one that will cost us all the most money in the long run is the wearing of tanning lotions and oils, which are prohibited from being used inside the pool. These substances will destroy our pool filters and require a very costly replacement. We ask that you please remind your guests.

Each of you that stay in Blue Jay during hurricane season should have an emergency plan that includes: 1. where you will stay if there is an evacuation; 2. supplies for 2-5 days; 3. medications; 4. important papers to take; 5. medical and pet accommodations. A reminder, the clubhouse cannot be used as an emergency shelter. Keep this in mind as hurricane season approaches. There are hurricane preparation guides in the clubhouse, and a link on the Pinellas County website with additional information.

It has been a busy month in Blue Jay. The boards providing a cap to the Pelican Lake wall have been replaced by our Blue Jay volunteers. Easily thousands of dollars were saved by these volunteers, and as always, we express our appreciation of their work. Our plumbing company installed a new shower valve at the pool. The outlet at the end of Gull Lake is scheduled to be replaced this week by an outside contractor. Without this intervention the outlet would have collapsed, emptying both Gull and Pelican Lakes.

This is a quick reminder on disposing of trash. Please remember that there are guidelines in the Blue Book that reference putting trash on the sidewalk. Trash in cans can be put out after 6 PM the night before, but trash in bags or bound by string or rope cannot be on the sidewalk before the morning of pickup. There have been recent occurrences of trash on a sidewalk days before pick up. Please help us keep Blue Jay looking beautiful.

Issues continue relative to homeowners starting projects on their home without Architectural Committee recommendation and Board approval. The purpose of approval is to ensure that changes conform to our documents. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to obtain this approval. Without approval you could be required to remove all changes and restore the property to its pre-work state. Do not let contractors begin work on your homes before getting approval. Not doing so could prove costly.





Then a Blue Jay resident passes away, it is our tradition to lower the flag to half-staff and place the residents name and information on the board for 3 days. Occasionally, we have more than one person pass away on the same day or within the 3 days of each other. We want to ensure that each person receives their 3 days of respect. We discussed the options in a Wednesday Social Club meeting and reached a consensus on the procedure we will follow moving forward.

The residents name will be placed on the board and the flag lowered as soon as possible once we receive official notification. This will remain for 3 full days. If another resident passes anytime during that 3 days their name will also be added to the board and the flag will remain lowered until it has been lowered for a full 3 days for the last person added to the board. At the end of each resident's 3 days their name will be removed.
