



Subject: Monthly Activity Report: April 2025

ear Fellow Residents:

Electrical Issues: A new power pole was installed behind the office. The power has been restored to the office, hall, spa, and pool. There was some misinformation circulating in the park regarding the spa and pool. While the power was limited to the office, the spa could not be used due to lack of available power. The hall air conditioning was also limited because of the limited power availability.

Hall Roof: A new flat roof is needed for the hall. The current roof is absorbing water and will not maintain integrity in the short run. The board has obtained three quotes and will select the appropriate contractor soon. In addition to the roof replacement, the hall needs to have gutters installed to avoid foundation damage from runoff from the roof. The total expense for these repairs is expected to be around \$85,000 not including the metal roof replacement. The metal roof has about twenty years of life remaining. The Board will be voting on an emergency use of reserve funds for the roof replacement.

Potable Water: Several pressurized galvanized pipes were found and isolated. This will avoid future leaks in the water system. Thanks to the water/sewer committee. Water use remains at normal levels.

Well Water: A meter has been installed on the well water system. The well water system maintenance is a large yearly expense for the park. The Board is interested in tracking the use of the well water to determine potential savings. Presently, the well water usage is running at about 15,000 gallons per day. If this were potable water, this would cost the residents several thousand dollars per month.

Sewer: the county has not yet secured additional funding for sewer replacement. The Board is still working parallel efforts, sewer replacement and private sewer license, to make sure that LSR follows the county regulations.

Pool Status: The pool treatment plant experienced a major pump failure. The pump housing cracked and flooded the equipment room. The pump was replaced, requiring an electrician to rewire the new pump. The new pump was also repositioned to avoid shorting from the "pit" in the pool room.

Roof Over Water/Heater Equipment: A new roof was installed over the well water systems and the Symbiont heaters. This should extend the life of the equipment by keeping the Florida sun from damaging the equipment.

Committees:

Park Improvement Committee: The committee formed to recommend improvements to the park using the funding from the extra maintenance fee collected in May has submitted their recommendations. The recommendations are:

The committee is continuing to work on recommendations for the front fountain and the signage in front of the hall. The Board will be reviewing these recommendations and acting as quickly as possible to implement the recommendations selected.

Ladies Restroom Committee: The ladies restroom committee completed their recommendations, and the Board selected a contractor to perform the work. A contract was signed with the contractor in the amount of approximately \$26,000. Part of this will be funded by the operating budget underrun of last year, part of the reserves that were funded, and the rest from the extra maintenance fee collected in May. The work is expected to begin in early May and be completed in early June. During construction, the Board will announce a plan for the ladies' restroom alternative.

Hall Windows: Vinyl coverings were installed on the hall and office windows and doors.

Laundry Exchange: The Board was approached by a resident who expressed a willingness to police a resident exchange area in the laundry room. This has been an area of discussion for some time. Until now, no residents have stepped forward to enforce rules and police an exchange in the laundry room. This resulted in board members policing the area and disposing of items left on the folding tables. The Board has agreed to the exchange area as long as the posted rules are followed. Thank you to the residents who volunteered for this effort.

Tool Lending: At the last Board meeting, the Board voted to prohibit the lending of any tools from the maintenance area to residents. This was necessary to avoid the cost incurred by the Park for missing, damaged, and broken tools.

Palm Tree Replacement: Palm tree replacement is being investigated for the park. Some residents have requested that trees not be replaced near their homes. The Board estimates up to 42 palm trees could be replaced. This is a significant expense and will be spread over a couple of years.

Feeding Wildlife: It is against Florida Statues to feed any wildlife. Songbird feeders are allowed, but it is not allowed to put food of any kind out for wildlife. Residents reported watching while a large alligator ate a duck near Lake Seminole. Someone has been seen leaving bird feed on the sidewalk for ducks and other birds. This incident with alligator should be a warning that even seemingly inconsequential actions may have serious ramifications.

Updated Rules: At the last board meeting, the Board voted to adopt updated rules for the Park. This action came after careful consideration and discussion with residents at town hall events. The updated rules were sent via email to all residents (who have registered emails with the office). During the time of the rule discussion, the Board found that the enforcement of the rules was somewhat laxed. On the advice of Counsel, the Board makes this proclamation:



SATURDAY, JUNE 14th 2025 IS FLAG DAY IN THE USA

hen the American Revolution broke out in 1775, the colonists were not fighting united under a single flag. Instead, most regiments participating in the war for independence against the British fought under their own flags. In June of 1775, the Second Continental Congress met in Philadelphia to create the Continental Army—a unified colonial fighting force—with the hopes of a more organized battle against its colonial oppressors. This led to the creation of what was, essentially, the first "American" flag, the Continental Colors. On June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress took a break from writing the Articles of Confederation and passed a resolution stating that "the flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white," and that "the union be 13 stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation." Over 100 years later, in 1916, President Woodrow Wilson marked the anniversary of that decree by officially establishing June 14 as Flag Day.

Canada has its own Flag Day celebrated on February 15 of each year. At the stroke of noon on February 15, 1965, Canada's red and white maple leaf flag was raised for the very first time on Parliament Hill. On the same day in 1996, National Flag of Canada Day was declared.

ST. JEAN BAPTISTE DAY IS ON TUESDAY, JUNE 24, 2025

t. Jean Baptiste Day is a national holiday in the Canadian province of Quebec and celebrated by French Canadians worldwide. The day honors the traditional feast day of the Nativity, or birth, of St. John the Baptist. It was brought to Canada by French settlers with the first mention of celebrations of Saint-Jean-Baptiste in North America dating back to 1606, when settlers on their way to the future Acadia, rested on the coast of Newfoundland. It was declared a public holiday in Quebec in 1925, with publicly financed events organized province-wide. This includes Saint-Jean-Baptiste parades which became an important tradition over time.

PINELLAS COUNTY EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

he Atlantic hurricane season begins June 1 and ends November 30 of each year. Historically in Florida, the most active time for hurricane development is mid-August through mid-October.

Pinellas County Emergency Management offers a free emergency notifications service, called Alert Pinellas that will send an email and/or a text to you to let you know about imminent severe weather. You can sign up for emergency notifications at https://pinellas.gov/alert-pinellas. You will need to establish a user name and a password for this site, but it is friendly and is easy to navigate. Both year-round residents and Snowbirds may sign up for this service. The site will not send out routine weather reports, but it will contact you when extreme weather is approaching our area. This includes tornado warnings, hurricane or tropical storm warnings, and any other weather event that may require residents to seek shelter or evacuate.

THE SUMMER SOLSTICE IN THE NORTHERN HEMISPHERE OCCURS ON FRIDAY, JUNE 20, 2025

The summer solstice is the longest day of the year that marks the start of the summer season. The solstice happens when the Earth arrives at the point where the North Pole is at its maximum tilt in relation to the sun. This is why days are longer during the Summer Solstice. During the Summer Solstice, the sun rises north of east and sets in the northwest because it is at its northernmost point in the sky. The sun is visible in the sky longer than usual making the Summer Solstice the longest day of the year. In case you wondered, in the Southern Hemisphere, the summer solstice takes place on Sunday, December 21, 2025 when the sun is at the farthest south.



BE ALERT TO SCAMS THAT TARGET SENIORS

The following information about scams that target seniors was compiled by the Bank of America. More scam alerts will appear in future newsletters.



Know how to spot an imposter - Imposters may pose as a trusted figure. They claim there's an issue and urge you to act quickly to resolve it.

What to watch out for:

- 1. Initial Contact: Scammers may reach out through various methods (social media, text, email, phone call, computer pop-up) and may claim:
 - There's fraud on your account, and you need to move or withdraw your money
 - They're an online romantic interest who needs money to resolve a crisis
 - It's the IRS and you have an unexpected overdue tax payment or are owed taxes
 - There was a failed package delivery attempt
 - Your computer has an issue that they can help fix
 - A job application needs personal details, like Social Security number, account number or PIN
 - There's an unexpected monthly fee for financial aid or tuition reimbursement
 - A company you do business with is providing a refund for overpayment
- 2. Deceptive instructions: If they tell you to do any of the following, pause and ask yourself, "Does what they're asking make sense?"
 - Withdraw cash and deposit it into your "new" account (which they provide the number for) via ATM, or in a digital currency ATM, like Bitcoin
 - Move money to your digital wallet and then move it to your "new" account number to resolve fraud
 - Click a link or download an attachment to provide your payment information
 - Share your personal identification number (PIN) or security code
 - Ignore warning messages as you follow their instructions
 - Say the bank is "in on" the fraud
 - Provide remote access to a device or download an app
 - Type a code into your device beginning with special characters (such as *72 or **21)
- 3. The scammer wins: If you follow their instructions
 - You'll have moved your money into the scammer's account (not your "new" account) where it's unlikely to be recovered
 - The scammer can use your personal and financial information to steal your money
 - They may install malware on your devices to steal information
 - Your incoming calls and texts may forward to the scammer if you typed *72 or **21 plus a number into your phone
 - They may demand money to restore access to your accounts or devices or to stop them from releasing your personal information




