






From the Board of Directors Roland Doucette, President

i Everyone, I hope you are all enjoying the summer months. I hear that the Loool is getting good use in the hot weather by homeowners and



guests. I am glad to hear that folks are taking advantage of the coolest place in the park! Please remember that part of the privilege of using the pool is exercising the appropriate responsibility. Please assure that you and your guests are following them.

The pool was recently inspected by the Pinellas County Health Department. As a result of the inspection, we are required to replace the drain cover in the deep end. This cover must be replaced every 7 years. A contract was signed with Triangle Pools to facilitate this request. The work should have been completed by the time you read this.

We also received our annual manhole inspection by Pinellas County. Our private system had 2 defects. The first one we were able to take care of ourselves for minimal cost and the work of volunteers. The second one required work to be done by a private contractor by Federal law. A contract was signed with Rooter Man of Tampa to facilitate this repair. It should be finished by your reading of this article as well.

It has been a pretty busy summer in Blue Jay and with several water breaks that needed to be repaired by the "pipe crew." We appreciate the money that was saved by their help. If you think there may be some issue that needs to be addressed, please put a notice "in the box," and then be patient, as some things require a "procedure," and that procedure can take some time to accomplish. We do, however, respond to all signed resident concerns. You are assured anonymity in anything you put in the box.

We have received another update to the upcoming Florida Department of Transportation project that is impacting us both directly and indirectly on Blue Jay. I do get weekly updates, and they speak to daily closures on Rt. 19. A recent project review, however, indicated that the completion date had been pushed back again, this time to sometime in 2029. Not bad for a project with an initial completion date of 2025.

The Board will be conducting a budget workshop in August to begin the process of putting together the budget for the calendar year 2026. The date of the workshop is Thursday, August 21st. It will be at the clubhouse at 2pm. Mark your calendar and try to be there. We always appreciate your input. The second and final workshop will be Thursday, September 18th, also at 2pm.

Finally, our Resident Occupancy Board Director Dan Karpf resigned effective June 15 for family reasons. Dan completely reorganized and modernized our residency system while he occupied that position, and he will be sorely missed. A special Board meeting was held on Thursday, June 26th for the purpose of replacing Dan on the Board. At that meeting



do my best to answer every question I receive about the history of Blue Jay. I research and answer each one to the best of my knowledge using the paperwork I have. The question was asked how many times has a home been sold here in Blue Jay since the beginning in 1979. There are two that are now with the 9th owner, #24 and #212. There are a number of homes that are with the 8th owner. Those are #42, #69, #153, #185, #186 and #193. There are several that are on their 7th and 6th owner.



The first home sold was to Jim and Rose Reid #25, they were from Canada. However, they were not the first residents of Blue Jay. That was Kenneth and Ann Adams #64. Both homes, #24 and #64 were set in 1979.

Just think, Blue Jay will be 50 years old in 2029. I hope a big party will be held to celebrate the occasion. A big celebration was held in January of 2004 when Blue Jay turned 25 years old. I still have the program from that event. Nope, not a pack rat just a keeper of Blue Jay History.



Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- · Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- · Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- · Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The **Federal Trade Commission** (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The **fraud department at your credit card issuers**, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.
