Briar Creek's creek has been cleaned up. Phase 1 and 2 joined forces to get vegetation and other debris that was blocking the flow of the creek removed. Thanks to Salvador Ramirez and his crew for getting the job done. Salvador's crew was wading, floating, and swimming at times to pull branches, trees, and other debris out of the creek. The plan, for the future, is to allocate money in future budgets to have a crew come in each year to trim back any overgrowth and pull out any branches and other debris that may have fallen into the creek.

Our next project for this summer will be to have our storm drains cleaned as some of them appear to be 70 to 80 percent blocked.

any of our owners are away on vacation or in their summer homes outside the community. At the recent Phase I board meeting in July, the board acknowledged in a cooperative effort with the Phase II board, the creek which runs through the community and exits into the Lake Tarpon outflow canal was cleared. The overgrowth and trees growing in the creek have been removed. This will allow a better flow on the creek during the storm season.

The Phase I community has 17 underground drains in various streets which lead to the main storm drains which flow into Briar Creek. The board approved a contract to clean out the sediment and debris accumulated in the drains over many years. This will also be complete for the storm season. This should allow a better flow of storm water into the creek.

The quality of lawncare service was again discussed. While the price we pay for this service in return for the level of care we receive is debatable, one owner asked for a show of hands of those present at the meeting who were willing to pay for an increase in the monthly maintenance fee for a possible increase in the level of service. Only one person raised their hand. Again, while debatable, the old saying of "You only get what you pay for" may be part of the equation. In this case we pay approximately \$24 per month per lot. The board will continue to attempt to push for more quality and service, cost for service will not be included in the discussions. Remember if you have an issue with the service, please call on the day of service while the crew and supervisor are on site. Discussing the issue with the worker may not help as their focus is on the task at hand.

If you have a list of items, you want the board to address and cannot attend a meeting, please send them to any director. We will attempt to change those things we can change, however there are things we have no control over and cannot change.





### **BOARD OF DIRECTORS MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING**

The seems to be some misunderstanding as to WHEN the monthly meeting takes place. The By-laws of Briar Creek 1 state:

- Lower Segular Meetings. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at the principal office of the Association at such times as shall be determined, from time to time, by a majority of the Directors. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be open to all Unit Owners who may participate in accordance with the written policy established from time to time by the Board of Directors. Notice of such meetings shall be posted at a designated location on the Condominium Property at least forty-eight (48) continuous hours in advance for the attention of the Members of the Association, except in the event of an emergency in which case the notice shall be posted as soon as practicable after the need for emergency meeting is known to the Association. All notices shall include an agenda for all known substantive matters to be discussed, or have an agenda attached to it...
- 5.8 Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Directors may be called by the President, and must be called by the President or Secretary at the written request of one-third (1/3) of the Directors. Special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be noticed and conducted in the same manner as provided herein for regular meetings.

Anyone who has purchased or leased in BC1 for more than ten (10) years has had the same Interview - New Residents Information. This information is covered and discussed with the potential owner/lease which states:

### **Board Meetings**

Briar Creek 1 is governed by a 7 member board, elected 3 one year, 4 the next year and etc.. Board of Directors business meeting is typically held the 1st Wednesday of each month from October-May. EXCEPTION is the December meeting which is held in conjunction with the Annual Meeting which is the first Monday in December at 10 am, which is the Annual Meeting of members which includes the election of Board members for the upcoming year. Generally, there are no board meetings during the summer unless there is an emergency. These meetings are held at the Clubhouse at approximately 10:00 a.m. Although a tentative schedule is posted for the year, each meeting's agenda is posted in the Clubhouse and on the website a minimum of 48 hours prior to confirm the meeting and Agenda.

For many years the established day and time has been the 1st Wednesday of each month at 10 a.m. following the Coffee Social. As a good number of residents attend the coffee social, this has been followed. BUT, there have been a few times when the President and Board at that time, moved the monthly BOARD meeting to Monday Night because a few owners stated they were still working and could not attend Wednesday at 10 a.m. and would like to be able to attend This only happened a few months because after the first couple of night meetings, there was no one at the night meeting that could not have attended the morning meeting.



The majority of the residents as well as the Directors at that time chose to return to the first Wednesday following Coffee at 10 a.m. Sometimes in the past there has also been a request by the majority of the BOARD to move the meeting up a week or a week early due to travel plans of BOARD members. The President is given this authority in our governing documents and has exercised his authority to do this.

Normally, as stated above, there has been no meeting during the summer needed but things have changed. Some things can wait, some cannot. Things have been a little hectic since 'Milton' damaged the Pedestrian Bridge behind the pool area. (Our creek needed a cleanout, storm sewers are filled with debre', pallets placed in the common elements at the end of Sugar Bear Drive by residents have become a safety hazard and need to be removed asap, our landscaping needs an update and regular maintenance, and of course, let's not forget the St. Petersburg Water Project. SHEW! It has been difficult to gather the information needed and once a bid is received, most contractors will only honor the bid for 30 days because of the fluctuation of material costs.

Our President announced at the May 28 meeting that there would be a meeting in July on the first Wednesday for follow up on bids for projects being considered. Bob also announced there would be another meeting upon receiving bids for the Pedestrian Bridge rebuild now that the engineer had submitted their drawings. And lest we forget, our BOARD members have a life outside their director's responsibility while volunteering to serve YOU! If you think their job is 'a piece of cake,' and you could do the job, sign up to run for the BOARD.

Remember, the pay is OUT OF THIS WORLD!



- If you do not want your lawn mowed, I suggest you put red flags around the area you do not want mowed. If you put up a large red sign it indicates to them that you do not want all of your lawn mowed and they will not mow it. This should work but if not call me and I will address it. Remember that these people are human and it is hot manual work and also there is a high turnover of workers due to the nature of the work and I'm sure the pay is low.
- Weed Application TLC applies weed killer periodically to the Clubhouse Area, the Front Entrance and the area around the Laundry Building (they apply it at the base of the fence surrounding the laundry drying yard to the left of the Laundry Building).

## RODENT PROBLEMS WITH BRIAR CREEK MANUFACTURED HOMES

Prenda and I had to learn how to get rid of our RAT PROBLEM. It has worked for many years at this point so that is why I am providing this article. We believe the only real solution is to DETER the rats from wanting to live under your HOME. Trying to kill them is a never-ending problem. When they die, they smell up your home for weeks. More will come if you FEED THEM. . .even though it is killing them.

It is a very common problem for the crawl space under the manufactured homes as well as the engine compartment of some vehicles. The location of the home may also have something to do with it. In my opinion, there is a best way to deal with the problem, based on years of dealing with the issue here in the park. Here is the best way to stop it at this time with some straightforward methods.

### **SOLUTION**

An inspection of your manufactured home will be necessary to see how well it is sealed to keep rat size openings not available to the rats. Newer homes seemed to have vinyl skirts that go to the ground which is one way. You should notice that there are vents in the vinyl as the area under the manufactured home needs ventilation. It is also a good idea to have a stone barrier IN the ground under the vinyl so rats cannot dig to get in. There are many ways to seal the entry space under the home, but it requires special reviewing to get it right and keep it in place. When we sealed our home, I wanted to be sure I had easy access all along the manufactured home in case I needed to get under wherever. My unit has the concrete standard block used throughout the park. I retrofitted screening in all of the openings between space blocks as ventilation is necessary to have the space under the home. This has worked for many years. Special care is necessary around difficult places like the A/C unit and electrical cabling, etc., but it is possible with a little care.

After the home is sealed up. . .opening small enough to keep rats out. . .we purchased an electronic Sounder/Strobe in the space and plugged it in an AC outlet. We purchased this unit from Amazon to install under our home. There is also a version to go under the hood of your car in the engine compartment. This electronic device provides animal sounds that rats do not want



to be near. Also, there are strobe lights that go off and on to cause them to stay awa. The audio volume can be adjusted to not hear it in our home or the neighbors' homes.

Amazon has had these products over the years but you certainly will find something like these units elsewhere that really work to keep the rats away.

We have this product! It has worked for several years at this point. Place this under your home. Rodent Repellent Ultrasonic Plug-in Indoor Mouse Repellent Rat Mice Deterrent Ultrasonic Pest Repeller with 12 Strobe Lights and 4 Sounds Mode for RV, Garage, Attic. The brand name is Angveirt and can be purchased for \$49. One should do it and you will need to plug it in..

We intend to buy this product! Mount Under the Hood of our Car Ultrasonic Rodent Repellent Under Hood Battery powered pest repeller humane mouse repellent for car engines basement, garage, attic rat mice deterrent 2 pack. The brand is Angveirt, it is battery operated, and can be purchased for \$29...two for under \$50..

Ray Jablonski has purchased similar items that have been working for him.

### **OUR NECK OUR POSTURE**

normal healthy neck has a C- shaped curve called a lordotic curve. This aligns for the proper biomechanics of the spine, shock absorption, range of motion, and holding our head upright for proper posture. As this curve diminishes the vertebrae and joints of the spine are compromised making the ligaments and muscles susceptible for injuries and dis-ease. Interestingly the loss of function, loss of motion, and forward head tilt does not always equate with pain. This is why it is so common since it occurs slowly where we are

not even noticing the minimal daily changes of degeneration. Anytime you observe someone standing or walking where their head is way out in front of their body or tilting downward you are witnessing years of gradual loss of the cervical curve. Though aging is not a dis-ease injuries over time, work related stress, all our daily habits being in front of computers, looking at our smart phones places our head in a forward position. Symptoms that can be present are headaches, fatigue, decrease of the range of motion, balance issues, as well as pinching nerves that exit out from the spine that affect the shoulders, arms, and hands.

So What Do We Do

- 1. Become conscious of our daily routines and our posture. Even as I am writing this article my head is forward placing stress to my cervical spine. So every 5 minutes change position, move your head and neck to reduce any fixation and tightening of the muscles.
- 2. Chiropractic Evaluation and care. Chiropractors will determine what stage cervical degeneration might be in, and what can be done to improve function and reverse the condition. Physical Therapy. Specific exercises and someone trained working with the muscles and ligaments can help reduce and improve these conditions.
- 3. Google Cervical exercise videos to regain posture for seniors. I have watched dozens of these. Find a few that you are comfortable with.

A few weeks ago I was playing a friend Singles on Tennis. After the match he shared that his neck and right shoulder felt really tight. And he remembered I was a chiropractor so he asked my opinion. I asked him if he was aware of his Posture and showed him how his neck was being pushed forward and his shoulders were being pulled inward. He said that was exactly what he was feeling. I showed him some exercises and sent him a few YouTube videos. When I saw him the following week he shared his problem was almost 100 percent improved and that he was doing the exercises daily.

Moral of the story. Be pro active, don't accept the notion of i am just getting older or nothing can be done. Hopefully we continue to get older, but let's all improve our ability to do the things we love for a long time. God bless

### Identity Theft

### Warning signs of identity theft

- · Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
  Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

### How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The **Federal Trade Commission** (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The **fraud department at your credit card issuers**, bank, and other places where you have accounts

### How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

### **Imposter Scam**

### The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.
