DO YOU KNOW THE FMO?

Sandy Hansen, FMO Park Representative, Lot #452, 727-586-1985

The FMO is working with a very slim budget: There are three paid entities that are paid from the dues: Legal Counsel, Legal Legislative Counsel, and Business Management Group as required by FMO Rules and Regulations. Everyone else including the Board of Directors, all District Presidents and Park Representatives volunteer their time expenses to keep the membership informed. Florida is 100% covered by an FMO district.

The membership is required to have a sixty day notice of every item that requires a vote by the FMO Board. Everyone will receive notice by email (if they have a valid email address on file) that yearly dues will be increased to \$40.00 beginning July 26. 2025.. If your dues are due by Sept. 25, 2025----you will renew at the existing dues amount-----if after Sept., 2025 your renewal will be at the new rate. As a gentle reminder, if you expire after Sept 25, 2025, attempts to pay ahead at the 2024 dues rate, it will not be excepted. At present of the FMO members in Four Seasons only two are in arrears.

The bills presented at the legislative session in the spring made it through every committee with 100% voting approval, but did not make it out of the last committee in time to be placed on the agenda. House Bill 701 and Senate Bill1140 will be discussed with the committee as to potential questions, then taken back to FMO committees to prepare it for prestation at the session is 2026. This bill is supported by FMHA and the FMO and provides several issues beneficial to the housing deficit in Florida.



- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- ☐ Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- ☐ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.






