




Recommended Items to Include in a Basic Emergency Supply Kit

- ☐ Water and non-perishable food for several days
- ☐ Extra cell phone battery or charger
- ☐ Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- \square Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- ☐ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- ☐ Fire Extinguisher Matches in a waterproof container Feminine supplies, personal hygiene items and hand sanitizer
- ☐ Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper towels
- ☐ Paper and pencil Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

NEW TOWING COMPANY AND EXPECTATIONS

Notification to park members via email June 13, 2025 from Robert Patrick, Community Association Manager

This is to inform you that we have hired a new Towing company that will begin services on July 1st. They will be looking for vehicles parked on the grass, cars parked on empty lots and vehicles parked on the street between 11pm to 6am. These will be immediate towable violations. They have been instructed not to tow anyone that is slightly parked on the grass by a tire length or less, but if your vehicle is parked totally on the grass, they will tow your vehicle. Make sure your vehicles are registered and have a license plate up to date.

Parking at the clubhouse and laundry facility for overnight parking spaces is still permittable, but you will need to get a signed and dated parking pass from the office prior to parking a vehicle there.

As per the state of Florida, any time your car is towed, there will be an immediate lien put on your vehicle at the sum of \$250.00. This does not include the tow price and/or storage fees. So, the total cost of your vehicle being towed could be as high as \$500 or more.

If your vehicle is towed, I will have the ability to look at pictures on their website for validation of the tow.

To avoid having your vehicle towed, please make sure you are parked in compliance with the Rules and Regulations and posted notices.



Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- · Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- · Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your **bank or a company you do business with.** You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.





REMINDER - HOW TO SURVIVE THE HOT DAYS OF SUMMER!

To stay cool during hot weather, prioritize hydration by drinking plenty of fluids, especially water, and consider eating water-rich foods like fruits and vegetables. Limit strenuous physical activity during the hottest parts of the day and seek shade when outdoors. Dress in loose-fitting, light-colored clothing and use fans to encourage airflow. Taking cool showers or baths, especially before bed, can help regulate body temperature.



Detailed Tips for Staying Cool:

Hydration is key:

Drink plenty of water throughout the day, even if you don't feel thirsty. Consider water-rich foods like fruits and vegetables.
