



- ☐ Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- \square Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- ☐ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- ☐ Fire Extinguisher Matches in a waterproof container Feminine supplies, personal hygiene items and hand sanitizer
- ☐ Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper towels
- ☐ Paper and pencil Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

POOL UPDATE NEWS

s everyone is aware our pool is being totally refurbished beginning August 4, 2025, it will be closed for approximately 5 to 6 weeks. While the work is being done Sunset Palms is letting our residences use their pool. Please be as respectful for their Pool Rules and Regulations as you are for ours.

RULE OF THE MONTH

XIV. Pool, Therapeutic Spa/Hot Tub, Recreation Areas. And Laundry:

- 1. There is no Lifeguard on duty. The use of the pool and Spa/Hot Tub is at your own risk.
- 2. You must shower before entering the pool, rules are posted at the pool and Spa/Hot Tub.
- 3. No one under the age of sixteen (16) is permitted without adult supervision.
- 4. The pool enclosure is open from 8:00 AM to 11:00PM. The time between 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM and 9:00 PM and 11:00 PM is reserved for adults 18 years and older.
- 5. Individuals who exit the pool or spa and apply suntan oil or soap must shower before reentering the pool or spa/hot tub.
- 6. No one in diapers in pool or spa/hot tub. Appropriate swimmies are allowed.
- 7. Pregnant women, small children, people with health problems, and people using alcohol, narcotics, or other drugs that can cause drowsiness should not use the spa/hot tub without first consulting a doctor.
- 8. No one is allowed in pool area when pool covers are in place.
- 9. No running in the pool enclosure. No diving or jumping into the pool or spa/hot tub
- 10. No beverages are allowed while in the pool or spa/hot tub.
- 11. No Food allowed in pool enclosure.
- 12. Non-alcoholic beverages are permitted in an unbreakable container with a lid. Glass containers of any kind are not permitted in the pool enclosure.
- 13. No coolers are allowed in pool eDo not attempt nclosure.
- 14. The therapeutic spa/ hot tub is for the exclusive use of the residents and their adult (18 years of age or older) guests.
- 15. Board of Directors approved assistance animals are permitted to accompany their owners into the pool enclosure but are not allowed in the pool or spa/hot tub.
- 16. Do not attempt to change the settings of the jets or the thermostat.
- 17. No more than 15 minutes in the spa/hot tub.
- 18. Rules posted in the billiards room, shuffleboard, and bocce courts must be adhered to on all occasions by Residents and guests.
- 19. Cooperation in keeping the Clubhouse, restrooms, and other utility buildings clean and serviceable is required. The Board of Directors requests that special attention be given to turning out lights and turning off water and shower faucets at the completion of use.
- 20. A coin-operated laundry is available to Golden Gate Residents only. Laundry room equipment, tubs, and floors must be left clean after use. Report any equipment not working to the office. Golden Gate is not responsible for any damage to articles washed or dried in the laundry.

Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- · Bills for items you did not buy
- · Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- · Denials of loan applications
- · Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- · Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.

ccording to our Golden Gate Lawyer, "we cannot require a Service Animal to wear a vest or provide certification. There is no certification that has any legal meaning."

We "can require that the person provide documentation of the disability and need for the animal if those things are not obvious (e.g. you cannot ask a blind person or person in a wheelchair for documentation of a disability)."

If the Board wants to request additional information, there are regulations on what can be asked.

Major Historical Events in August

 Princess Diana died in a car crash in Paris, sparking global mourning and conspiracy theories
