

The budget will reduce the monthly shareholder fee from \$677 to \$554 starting Aug. 1, 2025, a savings of \$123 per month per shareholder. 

PREPARATION IS THE KEY FOR FACING HURRICANE SEASON IN FLORIDA

Tune 1 through November 30 is Hurricane Season in Florida.

Preparation and planning is vital. Palm Hill homeowners who leave for the season are asked to put their shutters down and clear the home sites of any loose items that may become projectiles and damage other properties in the event of tropical storms or a hurricane.

<u>Please remember if you are a year-round resident to make sure that you have your plan in place NOW. Do not wait until there is a storm approaching.</u> For information on preparation, shelters, evacuation routes, and sandbags go to the Pinellas County website: https://pinellas.gov/department/emergency-management/.



From VI. HOMESITES AND CARE, MAINTENANCE OF PREMISES

To storage is permitted on the outside of or under homes. The single exception to this, no storage rule, is that one (1) small garden locker or deck box not to exceed approximately 50 cubic feet in volume and six (6) feet in height and designed for outdoor use is allowed. It must be securely placed against the side or back of a home and be of a color that is compatible with the color of the home. Each resident is required to keep their premises, to include the driveway and carport, free of debris.



Patios, driveways, and carports may not be used for the installation or storage of any appliances such as refrigerators, washers, or freezers and only items such

as gas grills and patio furniture which are intended and designed for outdoor use are allowed outside the enclosed spaces of the home which include the porch and Florida room. Because of limited parking in the park, a unit carport must be used such that it always allows space to park at least one automobile passenger vehicle.

SANITATION FIELD

PALM HILL RULES AND REGULATIONS, SECTION 6 – Q:

Use of Sanitation Area: The sanitation area is available for the purpose of material handling of recyclables, non-recyclables, vegetation, and construction materials.

The use of the construction bin shall be used strictly for the purposes of construction material and household items such as furniture. Renovation debris, such as kitchen cupboards, shall be broken down as to minimize the volume required of the construction bin. Electronics, tires, paints, oil, metals including aluminum, and hazardous materials are not permitted. Items that can be recycled should be separated and placed by the appropriate refuse or recycle bin. Recycled items are not to be taken/removed by a resident or individual. No dumping of construction material or refuse directly on the ground is permitted under any circumstance(s).

Should the construction bin be filled, the office shall be notified, and appropriate arrangements made for disposal.

Should such abuse of the sanitation area occur, the cost of such cleanup will be borne by the resident and may include suspension of access and associated fining. Sanitation facilities are restricted to Palm Hill homes only. All others, including commercial use by contractors, individuals outside the corporation, will be considered unauthorized and trespassing.


