August is upon us, and we find ourselves well into the dreaded dog days of summer, which are typically between July 3rd and August 12th. Surprisingly, at least to me, it turns out that the origin of the term "dog days of summer" has nothing to do with the heat discomfort of our panting canine friends and everything to do with unfounded ancient beliefs. The Greeks and Romans believed that the rising of the star Sirius into the summer night sky added to the sun's heat and made the weather hot, humid and quite uncomfortable. Sirius is known as the dog star in the constellation Canis Major, hence the term "dog days of summer".

Which brings us to one very important point. The high heat and humidity during the dog days of summer can be harmful to us and our pets. And like us, our pets can be susceptible to heat illness. So, keep them hydrated. Also, reducing a pet's food intake on warmer days can help your pet better cope with the heat. And you might want to avoid giving your pet a "hair" cut during the warmer months as their fur can act as insulation, blocking the heat of the sun from reaching their skin. So, watch the humidity, limit exercise on hot days, provide ample water, don't rely on a fan to cool your pet – they don't sweat to lower their body temperature – and check how hot the asphalt is to determine how safe it is to walk your pet. And remember, these guidelines apply to cats as well.

Which begs the question, why aren't there the cat days of summer? The constellation Leo has Regulus, one of the brightest stars in the night sky. And Leo the Lion is a feline. So, I did some digging and learned that the constellation Leo cannot be seen in the northern hemisphere in the summer. Which leads me to wonder, are there the cat days of winter?



Sign up for alerts at www.AlertLee.com to receive free calls, emails or texts info on Significant Emergencies, Critical Protective Actions Needed, How to Safeguard Life and property. Download the **WeatherSTEM** app on your phone to check for evacuations in our area. Have a plan, DO NOT GO TO A SHELTER! Shelters are for the desperately needy who have no way to go elsewhere. Make plans to go somewhere well in advance of an actual storm. Call friends or acquaintances now to be sure, if you don't know anyone who lives inland you can check for hotels, motels or Bed & Breakfasts inland away from the water where it will be safer. Get a copy of the Guide and check off the lists of items you will need to be ready. 






- ☐ Extra cell phone battery or charger
- ☐ Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- ☐ Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- ☐ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- ☐ Fire Extinguisher Matches in a waterproof container Feminine supplies, personal hygiene items and hand sanitizer
- ☐ Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper towels
- ☐ Paper and pencil Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children
