



Message from the President



reetings Shangri-La, It has come to my attention that some members feel they are not getting information from the HOA. We have a Facebook page, "Shangri-La 2023" to which we deliver information frequently. If you do not belong yet, please request membership.

Our personal telephone numbers are listed inside the front page of this very booklet, anyone can contact us with questions from 10:00 a.m. to 2 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Most of you know me, Nancy and John. We have been in this park for many years and have always done what is right for Shangri-La. Not to pat us on the back, but we have overseen a numerous improvements, such as:

- New washers and dryers (many administrations tried for years)
- Painted the front wall, maintenance shop and clubhouse.
- Painted inside the clubhouse.
- Upgrades to the clubhouse bathrooms (new floors and doors)
- Painted the pool deck
- Removed carpet and installed new tile on the patio deck.
- New pool furniture (and we expect to get 10 more chairs this fall)
- A new icemaker, microwave, refrigerator and stove
- A new hot water heater for the clubhouse
- A new roof on the clubhouse, including repairs of inside tiles.
- Ongoing repairs to pool screens
- Painted the interior of the billiards room with new pool cues and supplies
- Darts for the dartboard in the billiards room, and new horseshoes

And that's just off the top of my head.

Additionally, Management has helped numerous owners with property problems such as the drainage system at the end of 5th st and 1st Avenue, a huge undertaking that no other Manager wanted to tackle, yet it got done this past year.



Right now, Management is pressure washing sidewalks throughout the summer. In the fall the painting of the wall will continue. Please remember how hot and humid it is and we don't want our new maintenance man, Damon, to hurt himself.

Some of this may be maintenance that hadn't been done in years and shame on the previous managers for not getting things done for us.

The HOA has helped so many members by delivering food and helping them clean up their yards for the 360 inspections. We started a small food pantry, which we will be restocking soon.

We had our local representative, Berny Jacques, tour our park last October after the hurricanes. He brought with him the National Guard with MRE's and water.

That is thanks to your HOA! We reached out and our Rep showed up for us.

I say this as a reminder there is a lot the Board does behind the scenes.

We are working together with management to get things done. We may not get everything we want but we will keep trying to deliver for you all.

Thanks to those who stand by us! We will be better!

RECIPE

ere's a simple, refreshing summer recipe for Grilled Peach and Arugula Salad that's perfect for warm weather:Ingredients (serves 4):

- 4 ripe peaches, halved and pitted
- 5 cups arugula
- 1/4 cup crumbled goat cheese or feta
- 1/4 cup sliced almonds, toasted
- 1/4 red onion, thinly sliced
- 2 tbsp balsamic vinegar
- 3 tbsp extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 tsp honey
- Salt and pepper to taste



Instructions:

- Grill the Peaches: Preheat a grill or grill pan to medium-high. Lightly brush peach halves with olive oil. Grill cut-side down for 3-4 minutes until charred and slightly softened. Let cool, then slice into wedges.
- Make the Dressing: Whisk together balsamic vinegar, olive oil, honey, a pinch of salt, and pepper in a small bowl.
- Assemble the Salad: In a large bowl, toss arugula, red onion, and peach slices. Drizzle with dressing and gently toss to coat.
- Top and Serve: Sprinkle with goat cheese and toasted almonds. Serve immediately.

Why it's great for summer: The grilled peaches bring a sweet, smoky flavor that pairs perfectly with peppery arugula and tangy cheese. It's light, quick, and uses fresh, seasonal ingredients. Enjoy it as a side or add grilled chicken for a main dish!

It's the end of winter, with signs of early spring appearing in places like Australia and South Africa.


Cooler temperatures persist, but days begin to lengthen.

Major Historical Events in August



• English chemist Joseph Priestley successfully isolated oxygen, a major milestone in chemistry 1.

2 August 1990 – Iraq Invades Kuwait

• Saddam Hussein's forces invaded Kuwait, triggering the Gulf War and leading to Operation Desert Storm.

3 August 1492 – Columbus Sets Sail

• Christopher Columbus departed from Spain on his first voyage to the Americas with the Niña, the Pinta, and the Santa Maria.

4 August 1944 – Anne Frank Captured

• The Frank family was discovered by the Nazis in Amsterdam, leading to Anne Frank's eventual death in a concentration camp.

5 August 1962 – Marilyn Monroe Found Dead

• The iconic actress was found dead in her Los Angeles home, with her death ruled a probable suicide.

6 August 1945 – Atomic Bomb Dropped on Hiroshima

• The U.S. dropped the first atomic bomb on Hiroshima, Japan, killing tens of thousands and leading to the end of WWII.

8 August 1963 – The Great Train Robbery

• A gang of 15 men stole £2.6 million from a Royal Mail train in the UK, one of the most famous heists in history.

12 August 30 B.C. – Death of Cleopatra

• The Egyptian queen Cleopatra died, reportedly by suicide via snake bite, after her defeat by Octavian.

13 August 1961 – Construction of the Berlin Wall Begins

• East Germany began building the Berlin Wall, dividing East and West Berlin during the Cold War.

31 August 1997 – Death of Princess Diana

 Princess Diana died in a car crash in Paris, sparking global mourning and conspiracy theories

Recommended Items to Include in a Basic Emergency Supply Kit

- ☐ Water and non-perishable food for several days
- ☐ Extra cell phone battery or charger
- ☐ Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- ☐ Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- ☐ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- ☐ Fire Extinguisher Matches in a waterproof container Feminine supplies, personal hygiene items and hand sanitizer
- ☐ Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper towels
- ☐ Paper and pencil Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children


