




MANAGER'S CORNER

LURRICANE SEASON is June 1st – November 30th.
September is often cited as the peak month for hurricane activity and landfall. Warm water temperatures in the Atlantic can provide ideal conditions for storm development. Now is the time to prepare your home for a storm.



If you are complying with the Sunset Palms Rules & Regulations regarding your home, you are already preparing your property for a storm:

VII. HOMESITES #6, #14 and #18

- 6. All homes, carports, or any other items placed on a home site by a Resident must be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Management reserves the right to require repairs, repainting or other maintenance that is needed to comply with all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations of state, county, city, or Park, as amended from time to time.
- 14. Each Resident is required to keep their lot and driveway free of debris. Patios/carports may not be used for storage and only furniture designed for outdoor use is allowed outside the home. No shopping carts may be left or stored overnight in the carport or yard.
- 18. Storage: To avoid fire hazards and to promote safety, the space immediately under the home shall not be used for storage. Patios/carports may not be used for storage and storage on home sites is prohibited, unless written approval is received from Management.

While rules are in place for your safety and to keep harmony within the community, the importance of the rules listed above is even more evident during hurricane season. A category one hurricane has winds of 74 - 95 miles per hour. These high winds can damage or upend loose items and turn them into projectiles.

NOW is the time to walk your property and remove loose items that can be blown away during a storm. Flowerpots, lawn ornaments, loose furniture, grilles, hanging plants, and ladders can become airborne and damage your neighbor's property. Place them in your shed or bring them inside.

- ☐ Water and non-perishable food for several days
- ☐ Extra cell phone battery or charger
- ☐ Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- $\hfill\square$ Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.

he Clubhouse is available to all residents of Sunset Palms. It is used for meetings of the cooperative, social events (both large and small) and is also available for private events. The main hall and the library are scheduled independently, and things can get quite busy during the season.

In the event details box, please let us know if setup time is needed and what special arrangements are necessary. You will receive an email confirming that the event has been placed on the schedule.

Please be aware that all Social Committee sponsored events are to be approved by the Social Committee. Please reach out to Carol Eitenmiller, President (cmeitenmiller@yahoo.com) for pre-approval before requesting space in the Clubhouse. If a private party/event is requested, paperwork will need to be completed with the office staff, and a refundable deposit is required. Private events are subject to cancelation if use of the Clubhouse is needed for association events.

The Clubhouse is for your enjoyment. Don't forget that the library has books for you to check out. The exercise room has equipment and a pool table. Dart boards are there for your use. A Ping-Pong table will be available soon. Come on down and have some fun!


