





need to express gratitude to the Board, Residents and Legacy in their response to assist those impacted by the tornado. The community came together and helped each other as best HOMEOWNERS they could. As of this writing no updates on any projects have been ASSOCIA announced by Legacy.



One mission of the current board was to grow attendance to HOA meetings. Especially during the summer when our snowbirds are up north and for residents who might not be able to physically attend a meeting but want to stay informed. Therefore, the HOA has been working on setting up a Teams event for HOA meetings for members/residents who want to attend virtually.

Microsoft Teams works best from a laptop or tablet. You will be sent a link via email with instructions on how to join the meeting. There is an application for windows or Mac computers and tablets. It's not necessary to be able to join but helpful. If you're reading this online, you can use this address:

Sydney will monitor the meeting. All attendees will be muted to prevent background noise. There is a chat feature where questions can be asked. And will be answered/addressed at the appropriate time in the meeting.

By providing this our hope is to also grow our membership numbers. Currently only 15% of all residents are dues paying members of the HOA, which gives you the ability to vote in the election of your board and on any motions affecting the community.

By the time this is published we will have had our August meeting using **Teams**. If you're interested in being able to attend meetings virtually, we need your email address on file. We will be verifying that everyone requesting to attend is a resident to make sure Ranchero business stays in Ranchero.

Looking ahead to fun things to do in the post hurricane months, the transportation committee has planned 3 bus trips to the dinner theatre. (See the Bus Trip section for details). They are still looking for ideas of places to go and volunteers to help attend the trips as a coordinator in the absence of a committee or board member.
