





s promised, here is your winter 2025/spring 2026 calendar. For those who are new and curious about why we schedule so far in advance here is your answer. As a group at our meetings the year before we all toss around ideas. There is a breakfast each month from December thru March. A holiday celebration in December. Also, a dinner/dance from January thru March. We decide on the dates for each event. Occasionally there will be a fun event in the planning. Next comes the theme for the dances. Then music has to be booked for the dances. Most are a year in advance. Once these are established, we look for volunteers, be it one individual or group to host these events. If no one is found then the social club steps in. A host is responsible for menu planning, food buying and preparation, getting their helpers and kitchen clean up after. The social club takes care of all decorations and club clean up after. There is a budget for each event. But we do not abandon our hosts. We are there for questions, concerns and help if needed. We want it to be an enjoyable experience for all. Then we go to the office to secure our dates to reserve the clubhouse. We normally reserve the day before for preparation and setup and the entire day of the event to finish getting ready. Then we will start on Wednesdays from 10-noon in the library in November selling tickets to events. All sales will stop the Wednesday before the event. This is to get a head count to allow proper purchase of food items for the dinner. The menu will be listed ahead of each event. As it gets closer, we will give a start date for ticket sales. This year all tickets for events will be available. If you would like to plan ahead and get them all at once, we will have them. We also like to put our schedule out so you have time to prepare. As all dances have a theme it's fun to see all the wonderful outfits to match the event. I'm sure there are things I may have missed about what goes on to get to this point so don't be afraid to ask. We'll see you on Wednesdays for tickets. All events are in the clubhouse. Breakfast is served at 9AM. Dinner is served at 6PM and the band starts at 7PM. Doors open 30 minutes prior to all events for seating. Dinner/dances have reserved seating. If you want to sit with friends, it would be advisable to get your tickets early. No holds on tables. There are eight to a table. No extra chairs will be added to a table. This just makes dinner service easier on the helpers. But after it's finished you are welcome to move around. We want everyone to have a great time from the hosts, volunteers and of course you, our friends and neighbors who make all of this possible. And if you have ideas or are thinking about hosting, we would love to hear from you.






