

MEETING WITH MANAGEMENT

Discussed underage residents living in park. Issue already addressed. Guidance for people who park in street overnight. Management has asked residents to refer to office. Issue about person walking dog in everyone's yard. Resident will be sent letter advising of rules. Maintenance trying to clean up and dig out sluesways to provide for better drainage. Management requests that residents refer drainage issues to office. Duck issue –

Management has found company to remove ducks legally. Some are protected so permits have to be obtained to move them. Additional rat bate boxes will be put out Monday. Issue with woman leaving cats outside – will be sent letter reminding her of rules. Asked about backup propane and clubhouse access during hurricane season. Management has plenty of back up tanks and will allow residents to use electricity in clubhouse and kitchen facilities if power is out during hurricane. Issue of speed humps tabled until October so board can bring it up in HOA Board meeting on Oct. 7.



What Is and Why Join the FMO

Thy Join the FMO? FMO is the Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida. The Federation's purpose is to promote its members' general welfare, protect their rights and interests, and be a consumer advocate for manufactured/mobile homeowners. FMO members are current, former, and future manufactured homeowners who care about our lifestyle and hope to make a difference at the state level. Their accomplishments are numerous and include the creation of Florida Statute 723, "The Florida Mobile Home Act", which safeguards your rights as homeowners in Florida. Most recently the FMO successfully lobbied for the extension of The Mobile Home Tie Down Program for 10 more years. We owe all of our success to our dedicated members. Please visit the FMO website at: https://www. fmo.org We hope you'll find the information and resources on their website useful and help join us in our fight to protect our lifestyle. Together we can, and do, make a difference! This is information on a FMO proposed piece of legislation for 2025: ISSUE: Florida is home to hundreds of thousands who have chosen the lifestyle found in manufactured/mobile home communities and parks. Many live on fixed incomes without the ability to increase their income. In many cases our mobile home residents are forced to choose between paying the lot rent or buying food and medicine. PROPOSAL: During the 2025 Regular Session, FMO will work to amend sections of Chapter 420 to assist mobile home owners who own their homes that are placed on leased land with lot rent payments. Assistance will be based on the home owner's financial need. Draft language to accomplish this has been placed with the House and Senate Bill Drafting Offices. FMO supports home owner's concerns about lot rent increases. We must eliminate the discrimination that exists against mobile homes within the larger conversation about affordable housing.

Origins & History

• Ancient Celtic Festival of Samhain: Halloween traces back over 2,000 years to the Celtic festival of Samhain, marking the end of the harvest and the beginning of winter. Celts believed that on this night, the boundary between the living and the dead blurred, allowing spirits to roam the earth.


