



The Canadian Thanksgiving History

TX Tatch for the American Thanksgiving History next month.

Early Influences

• Indigenous Traditions:

Indigenous Peoples in North America held harvest celebrations, including prayers, dances, and feasts, long before European arrival.

• Martin Frobisher's Voyage (1578):

Explorer Martin Frobisher held a ceremony in Newfoundland, giving thanks for his crew's safe arrival after a failed attempt to find the Northwest Passage.

• French Settlers:

Samuel de Champlain and French settlers also held feasts of thanks with Indigenous neighbours in the 17th century.

From Colonial Times to National Holiday

• Varied Dates and Themes:

After the 1763 British acquisition of New France, various Thanksgiving days were held in the colonies, often to celebrate military victories or good harvests.



• Official National Holiday (1879):

<u>Sir John A. Macdonald</u>, Canada's first Prime Minister, officially declared Thanksgiving as a national holiday in 1879, recognizing a successful harvest.

• A Move to November:

For a period in the early 20th century, Thanksgiving was sometimes observed on the same day as <u>Armistice Day</u> (later Remembrance Day).

Establishing the Modern Holiday

• Fixed Date:

In 1957, Parliament officially proclaimed the second Monday in October as the permanent date for Canadian Thanksgiving, a tradition that continues today.

• Harvest and Community:

The modern holiday continues to emphasize gratitude for the harvest and the gathering of family and friends for a shared meal.







When the Romans conquered Celtic lands, they blended Samhain with their own festivals:

- Feralia honoring the dead.
- Pomona goddess of fruit and trees

Later, the Christian Church renamed the season:

- † November 1 became All Saints' Day (All Hallows' Day).
- → The evening before, All Hallows' Eve, soon became Halloween.

Old Traditions, New World

- € Children practiced "souling"—going door-to-door offering prayers for the dead in exchange for food.






