



October Men's Club

id you know that all male residents in Golden Gate park automatically belong to the Men's Club?

The "Men's Club's Constitution & By-Laws" is only 6 pages that are half the size of standard 8.5x11" letter paper with very wide margins. It's nothing to be afraid of.

Article III.A states:

"The membership shall be limited to any male person (or persons) residing in Golden Gate Community. All such members shall have a right to vote and hold office and voice their opinion in any matter before the group."

SPINACH NOODLE CASSEROLE

- 1 c sour cream
- sauce

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease 8x8x2 inch glass baking dish. Blend all ingredients in large bowl. Spoon mixture into prepared dish and sprinkle with grated cheese. Place pan in larger pan containing water. Bake until set, about 45 minutes. Let stand for 10 minutes.
