

President's Report

Philip Quince

Ear Residents,

It's wonderful to see so many of you returning to the Cove and enjoying our community events. We're excited to reconnect and hear about your summer adventures.

As we enter our busiest months, the Board has been actively working on two important initiatives:

• The annual budget proposal

• A ballot amendment to revise the two-thirds (2/3) voting requirement in our Declaration of Master Occupancy Agreement (MOA)

This amendment has been discussed for several years, and we believe now is the time to move forward. It's a change that will benefit not only the current Board but also future volunteers who serve our community.

Why This Matters

Currently, the Master Occupancy requires two-thirds (2/3) of all eligible members to approve of any changes. The challenge is low participation—in a typical year, up to 200 members do not vote at all.

Example:

- 642 eligible members
- 428 yes votes required to pass
- If 200 members don't vote, we'd need 428 yes votes out of 442 participants
- That means just 15 no votes can block a proposal supported by the vast majority

We believe this is **unfair** and has prevented progress for many years.

Proposed Change

We recommend changing the requirement to:

Two-thirds (2/3) of members who are present and voting (in person or by proxy) at a meeting where a quorum is present

Using the same numbers:

- 442 participants
- 295 yes votes needed to pass
- 148 no votes to reject

This approach better reflects the will of those who are engaged and invested in our community's governance.

Please watch for upcoming **town halls and forums** where you can ask questions and learn more before casting your vote.

Treasurer/ Maintaining a Reserve Account

Thy Every Homeowners Association Should Maintain a Reserve Account Homeowners Associations (CO-OPS) keep reserve accounts to be ready for big repairs and replacements of community assets, which helps keep property values up and the community stable. Having enough money in these reserves means homeowners won't get hit with sudden big bills and can plan for the long haul.

- Keeping property values up: A well-funded reserve means repairs and maintenance happen on time, so the community stays nice and appeals to buyers and appraisers.
- Avoiding big surprise bills: Regular contributions to the reserve spread out repair costs over time, so homeowners don't get slammed with huge one-time charges that can cause financial stress and community drama.
- Timely maintenance: With enough reserves, repairs on aging infrastructure can happen promptly, reducing safety risks and preventing expensive damage from putting off maintenance.
- Meeting lender and legal requirements: Keeping reserve funds in check meets lender and insurance standards and state laws, making properties more marketable and protecting the HOA from legal and financial issues.

Our recent reserve study is available on the WEB site and copies can be requested from the office. If you have questions feel free to email the Treasurer.



Homeowners Insurance: How To Obtain

ast month we discussed obtaining a home loan for manufactured housing. This month, we are reviewing homeowner's insurance since lenders require that a homeowner carry homeowner's insurance if obtaining a loan.

Manufactured homes of any age can obtain insurance, but the issue is this: Can a homeowner obtain enough insurance on an older home to satisfy the requirements of the lender? Often on an older home that was built in the 1970s or even 1980s, it is difficult to obtain enough insurance to meet the lender requirements. A home built in 1975 is 50 years old, so it's not surprising that it is difficult to meet the lender requirements unless the home has been completely remodeled and an appraisal is completed to include all of the upgrades.

That's why with many older homes, buyers will pay cash as it makes more sense when factoring the cost of the loan and the cost of insurance.

On a home that was built in 1990s and 2000s, it is easier to find insurance that will meet the lender requirements, but a buyer must weigh the monthly expense for the loan, which will include taxes and insurance, versus paying cash.

Finally, the insurance industry in Florida is difficult for all homeowners, no matter what type of housing they live in, explains Broker Marty Pozgay. "An insurance company can't write every policy in a particular area," said Pozgay. "Instead, one company may have 50 policies (as an example) that it can write in the St Petersburg area, and then once they reach capacity, that company can no longer take any new customers. That's why homeowners have to shop around with many different insurance companies to find one that has the capacity within a particular zip code or city."

Also note that there are few to no insurance companies that are writing a homeowner's insurance policy without a flood policy if a home is located in a flood zone, which Americana Cove is. "If a homeowner who lives in a flood zone is trying to find a homeowners policy without taking flood, it probably can't be found," Pozgay explained.

Barefoot Realty has a list of insurance agents who write for different insurance companies and who are experienced with manufactured housing. Contact a Barefoot Realty agent if you would like this list.


