

Homeowners Association

The Clubhouse is finally open. Kudos to Anthony who took it upon himself to chair an impromptu party. The theme was Hawaiian shirts and dresses. We had a great turnout, better than expected. Thank You to all who assisted him with the preparations, cooking and clean up. Thanks to Orange Rust Band who entertained us free of charge.

There has been a lot of negative publicity lately about HOA's. In a HOA where the residents own the common areas, they are the final authority on any matter concerning their rules and regulations. Our Park is an HOA on a leased land community. The Park Owners retain legal ownership of the land and all common areas such as the Clubhouse, pool, and all other common areas. Our HOA gives Tenants a collective voice in dealing with this landlord who also has the final say over the property itself.

Our HOA responsibilities include representing residents to discuss issues such as rent increases and any new rule modifications involving Park matters. Also to encourage compliance with our community rules and regulations to create a harmonious living environment. Some of the Homeowners' responsibilities include paying lot rent on time, keeping our homes and the leased land reasonably clean and safe and following the Park Rules accordingly.

All social events must be approved by the Park Manager. We must submit a year in advance our social calendar for the following year. Any spontaneous activities must also be approved. In the event of an injury during an event in the common area, the Liability falls on the Park Owner thereby making them the ultimate authority on event policies. You are responsible for any injuries on your lot. It is assumed that residents should have at least Liability Insurance to protect themselves.

We are under the wing of the Florida Manufacturers Homeowners (FMO). That is why we are incorporated as an HOA instead of a Resident Association. We are focused on protecting the rights and interests of all our residents, not just those who belong to the HOA. Management must give us a ninety-day notice before making any changes to our rent and regulations. They are instrumental in informing our members about State Laws such as Florida Statue 723. Also, if the Park Owners ever attempt to sell our park, the HOA would have the first opportunity at purchasing the Park.

CTOBER 6, 2025 HOA MEMBERSHIP MEETING

It's that time of year where we are fast approaching the HOA Board of Directors elections. There will be 6 positions open.

If you are interested in being a director please let the Nominating Committee of your intention, (Michele Gardner, Jenny Bilicki, Jessie Bohnert, Colleen Talbot)

Voting will take place on December 1, 2025 HOA membership meeting, nominations will be taken from the floor at the October 6, 2025 meeting.

(Article X Section3)

Anyone who is nominated from the floor must be present to accept said nomination, or must provide written notice of their willingness to serve before the meeting at which they anticipate being nominated.

(Article V Directors/Officers Section 1

No residents can be directors if they reside in the park for less than five (5) months. The make-up of the Board of Directors must be minimum of seven 7 full-time residents and the other two (2) residents must reside in the park a minimum of five (5) months.)

At present, 3 of our residents have expressed their desire to run and have submitted their names. You must be a paid member by December 1, 2025 to run for the position and to be able to vote. See Michele Gardner for membership.
