Greek Recipes

very year in October the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church in Clearwater holds a Greek Festival with food, music and dancing. You can share this Greek meal with your friends.

2 large eggs

1 tsp. oregano

1 large yellow onion, chopped

1/8 tsp. salt and pepper

1/4 c. milk

GREEK PASTITSIO - 6 servings

6 oz. elbow macaroni

1/2 c. feta cheese, cubed or 1/3 c. Parmesan cheese

12 oz. ground beef or lamb

1-3/4 c. chopped tomatoes or 1 (14-1/2 oz) can tomatoes


1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon

2/3 c. Parmesan cheese

TOPPING: 1-1/2 c. milk 2 Tbsp. flour 1/4 tsp. salt and black pepper

1/4 c. Parmesan cheese

- 1. Cook macaroni, drain, rinse, and drain again. Separate eggs. In small bowl, lightly beat the yolks; set aside for topping. Stir the egg whites, feta cheese, and 1/4 c. milk into macaroni. Set aside.
- 2. In large skillet, cook meat and onion until browned. Drain off fat. Stir in tomatoes, oregano, cinnamon, salt, and pepper. Bring to boil. Simmer, covered, for 5 min. Remove from heat; stir in Parmesan cheese. Layer half of macaroni mixture in lightly greased 8 x 8 x 2 dish. Top with meat filling, then with remaining macaroni mixture.
- 3. Topping: In medium saucepan, whisk together the milk, flour, salt, and pepper. Cook over moderate heat, whisking constantly, for 8 min. or until thickened. Slowly stir 1 c. of the hot mixture into lightly beaten egg yolks; return mixture to saucepan. Cook, stirring constantly, for 3 min or until thickened (do not boil). Stir in Parmesan cheese. Pour sauce over macaroni layer. Bake at 350 for 30 35 min. Let stand 10 min. before serving.





BAKLAVA

FILLING: Stir together 4 c. finely chopped walnuts, 1/2 c. sugar, and 1 tsp. cinnamon; set aside:

1 (16 oz) pkg. phyllo dough, thawed 1-1/4 c. butter, melted

SYRUP FOR TOPPING: 1-1/2 c. sugar, 1 c. water, 1/4 c. honey, 1/2 tsp. finely shredded lemon peel, 2 Tbsp. lemon juice, 2 inches stick cinnamon

- 1. Brush bottom of 15 x 10x1 in. baking pan with some of melted butter. Layer 5 phyllo sheets in pan, generously brush each sheet with melted butter as you layer, and allowing phyllo to extend up sides of the pan. Sprinkle 1-1/2 c. of filling on top of phyllo. Repeat layering phyllo sheets and filling twice. Layer remaining phyllo sheets atop the third layer of filling, brushing each sheet with butter before adding next sheet. Drizzle any remaining butter over the top layers. Trim edges of phyllo to fit the pan. Using a sharp knife, cut through all the layers to make 60 diamond, triangle, or square shaped pieces. Bake in 325 oven for 35 to 45 min. or till golden. Slightly cool baklava in pan.
- 2. In medium saucepan, stir together the remaining 1-1/2 c. sugar, water, honey, lemon peel, lemon juice, and stick cinnamon. Bring to boiling; reduce heat. Simmer, uncovered, for 20 min. Remove cinnamon. Pour mixture over slightly cooled baklava in the pan. Cool completely.
