

## **RECIPE**

Tere's a simple, cozy Pumpkin Soup recipe perfect for autumn:Ingredients (Serves 4):

- 1 small pumpkin (about 2 lbs), peeled, seeded, and cubed (or 1 can pumpkin puree)
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 3 cups vegetable broth
- 1 cup heavy cream (or coconut milk for a lighter option)
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Optional: toasted pumpkin seeds or fresh parsley for garnish



## **Instructions:**

- 1. Heat olive oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add onion and garlic, sauté until soft (about 5 minutes).
- 2. Add pumpkin cubes and vegetable broth. Bring to a boil, then reduce to a simmer for 15-20 minutes until pumpkin is tender. (If using puree, simmer for 10 minutes.)
- 3. Blend the mixture until smooth using an immersion blender or in batches with a regular blender.
- 4. Stir in cream, cinnamon, nutmeg, salt, and pepper. Heat through for 5 minutes, but don't | boil.
- 5. Serve hot, garnished with toasted pumpkin seeds or parsley.

Why it's **autumnal**: The warm spices and pumpkin scream fall, plus it's hearty and comforting for cooler days. Enjoy with crusty bread!












## Halloween



• Ancient Celtic Festival of Samhain: Halloween traces back over 2,000 years to the Celtic festival of Samhain, marking the end of the harvest and the beginning of winter. Celts believed that on this night, the boundary between the living and the dead blurred, allowing spirits to roam the earth.



- **Christian Influence:** In the 8th century, Pope Gregory III designated November 1 as All Saints' Day, and the night before became known as All Hallows' Eve, eventually shortened to Halloween.
- American Evolution: Irish and Scottish immigrants brought Halloween to the U.S. in the 19th century. It evolved from somber spiritual traditions into a fun, community-centered celebration.

## Traditions & Activities

- **Trick-or-Treating:** Children dress in costumes and go door-to-door saying "Trick or treat!" to receive candy. This practice stems from medieval "souling," where people collected food in exchange for prayers.
- Costume Parties: People of all ages wear costumes ranging from spooky creatures to pop culture icons and attend themed parties.
- Pumpkin Carving & Jack-o'-Lanterns: Inspired by Irish folklore about "Stingy Jack," people carve pumpkins into faces and light them with candles to ward off spirits.
- Haunted Houses & Corn Mazes: These attractions offer spooky thrills with eerie decorations, jump scares, and ghostly themes.
- Horror Movies & Storytelling: Watching scary films and sharing ghost stories are popular ways to embrace Halloween's eerie vibe.

## **Symbols & Superstitions**

- Ghosts & Spirits: Represent the belief that the dead return on Halloween night.
- Witches & Black Cats: Associated with magic and superstition.
- Skeletons & Gravestones: Symbolize death and the afterlife.
- Bats & Spiders: Creatures of the night that add to the spooky atmosphere.



## Dishes with portion-control markers effective

ometimes simple ideas work best. That seems to be the case with a plate and cereal bowl equipped with markers for proper portion sizes when it comes to helping people lose weight. The dishes appear to help obese patients with diabetes lose weight and decrease their use of glucose-controlling medications, according to a report in the Archives of Internal Medicine.

In the past 40 years, the number of obese U.S. adults increased from 13.4 percent to 30.9 percent—and most cases of Type-2 diabetes can be attributed directly to obesity. When you consider that restricting calories has been shown to improve blood sugar control in diabetics, in part by controlling weight, you get an idea of how powerful a simple tool like a portion-control dish can be. Many studies have shown the number of calories ingested is directly related to the serving size offered. At a time when restaurants seem to be offering ever-larger meals, and the rate of obesity is soaring, most people seem to be unable to determine what correct portion size is on their own.

Researchers at the University of Calgary conducted a six-month study of commercially available portion-control plates and bowls. The plates were divided into sections for carbohydrates, proteins, cheese and sauce, with the rest left open for vegetables. The plates provided for appropriate calorie intake for men (approximately 800 calories) and women (approximately 650 calories). The cereal bowl held a 200-calorie meal of cereal and milk.

Half of the study participants used the plates; the other half received the usual care of being instructed by dietitians. Those using the plates and bowls lost an average of 1.8 percent of their body weight as com-pared to those not using the plates, who lost an average of 0.1 percent of their body weight. Significantly, 16.9 percent of those using the portion-control plates lost 5 percent of their body weight as opposed to 4.6 percent of those who did not use the plates. Researchers say this is important because a 5 percent weight loss has been shown to decrease morbidity and mortality associated with obesity-linked disorders such as cancer and heart attack. Additionally, 26.2 percent of those who used the portion-control plates decreased their use of diabetes medications after six months as opposed to

10.8 percent of those who did not use the plates. Researchers say these inexpensive tools can help overweight populations with and without diabetes.






