

Legacy has reached out to inform us that they have had staffing changes that affect our capital improvement project. At the time this article is being written we are currently waiting for a meeting to be introduced to the new team and discuss the progress and future improvements for Ranchero.

Looking for email addresses

Since Legacy launched the new ResidentPortal in August 2025, the new software will not allow them to send out email blasts to all residents with an email address on file.

- The HOA is trying to help with this issue until Legacy corrects this problem.
- The HOA has almost 300 email addresses on file. These email addresses are from HOA
 members and non-members that provided an email address when attending an HOA
 meeting.
- We (the HOA) have requested Legacy to provide us with a complete email list of residents, however, this may or may not be doable due to Legacy policies.
- By compiling a list of resident email addresses, the HOA will be able to send out blast messages to alert residents of issues (as communicated to the HOA by Legacy).
- We are asking residents to voluntarily provide the HOA with a valid email address so we may contact you in events such as a water shut-off, clubhouse closures, etc.





THE DUKE ENERGY-WISE PROGRAM

t one of our Saturday coffee gatherings, three representatives from Duke Energy spoke to us about the EnergyWise program. The purpose of the program is to help reduce the load on the grid during high usage times to avoid having the whole grid go down.




If you participate, you will receive credit on your bill if you use a minimum of 600kwh, with a maximum of 900kwh. I looked back through my bills and I had multiple months of credit ranging from \$3.50, up to \$7.50. They claim the impact to your home is minimal and you may not even notice it.

They wanted to give us a heads up that in an effort to update the equipment, they would be walking around Ranchero trying to identify who might already have the equipment installed near their air conditioners. They will have reflective vests on and will have their Duke Energy badges clearly visible. (They repeatedly asked that we not shoot them if we see them wandering around!)

Some of us might be grandfathered into the program by the previous home owner without

knowing it. There are two ways to tell. One is that you have a gray box installed next to your air conditioner, and the other is by looking at your monthly bill. Here is an example of what the EnergyWise credit line looks like:

Contact Duke Energy to let them know you have the equipment so they can replace it with the updated technology. Or contact them if you want to discuss participating in the program. You can call them at: 877-574-0341, the Call Center in St. Pete. And please be nice to the guys if you see them walking around!


