Recipe Row

Jiffy Corn Caasserole – I make this recipe all year long! (Linda)

Ingredients

- Cooking spray or butter, for the baking dish
- 8 tablespoons (1 stick) unsalted butter
- 1 (15-ounce) can corn kernels
- 8 ounces sour cream (1 cup)
- 2 large eggs
- 1 (15-ounce) can creamed corn
- 1 (8.5-ounce) box regular or vegetarian Jiffy corn muffin mix
