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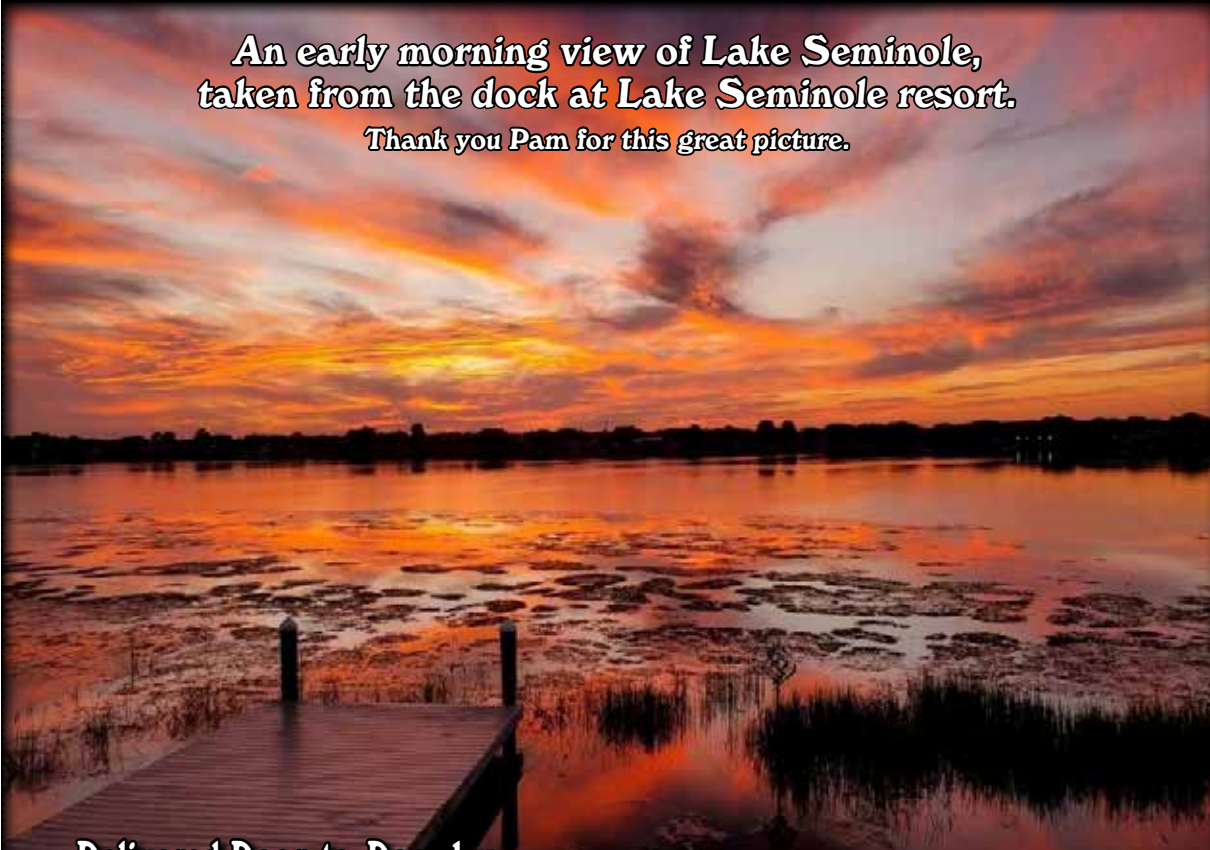

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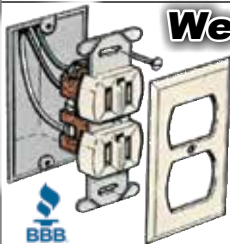

1. **All renters/visitors required to register and apply for background check at the office. Show proof of age. Owners check-in and also leave departure date. Update your information.**
2. Permit required for overnight parking in **designated** areas. Overnight street parking is not permitted. Obtain permit at office (5-L) during office hours.
3. Speed Limit in park: 10 MPH. Be aware of other cars when parking on streets. They are very narrow. Emergency vehicles should be able to pass easily.
4. Check Clubhouse Activity Room # 1 for information on possible sales or rentals available.
5. Children must be accompanied by resident adult to use Pool & Clubhouse. **All residents are to wear cover-up or Tee shirt when in clubhouse. DO NOT WALK INTO CLUBHOUSE WITH WET FEET!**
6. **SAFETY HINT:** Use a **FLASHLIGHT** when walking during the dark hours after 6:00P. Golf Carts turn lights **ON**.
7. Residents should have Emergency Contact information in their office file, in case of medical problem or weather emergency.
8. Any requests for our maintenance staff is to be submitted, IN WRITING, so work order can be generated. No verbal requests, please.

Pointe West Community Organizations

1. **Residents Owned Community - ROC**
 - a. Residents who bought a share in community which owns the land. They display a black permanent tag on their coach.
 - b. These residents pay real estate taxes to Pinellas County.
 - c. They pay a monthly maintenance fee to the ROC.
 - d. Organization elects residents to the Board to govern the running of Pointe West. These (9) directors elect yearly: a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer.
2. **Recreation Association - REC**
 - a. All residents are eligible to join, paying \$2.50 per person for life.
 - b. It's managed by a Board of Directors (9) for rotating three year terms. They then elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer each year.
 - c. They plan a Social calendar for winter and summer seasons.
3. **Home Owners' Association - HOA**
 - a. Pointe West Homeowners Association Inc. A not-for profit corporation. The H.O.A. is by law, the official and legally recognized representative.
 - b. Members – Non-shareholders who rent their lots here regarding , rent increases, park rules and regulations, park amenities, state governing statutes.
4. **Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc.**
(FMO) 420 Portsmouth Rd., Largo, Florida (727)530-7539
 - a. Members – Florida manufactured homeowners.
 - b. Objectives – represents MFHO regarding state legislation And statutes in Florida.

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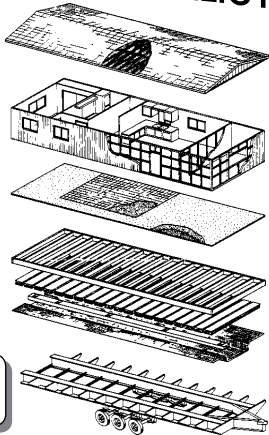
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Thanksgiving Dinner at Pointe West

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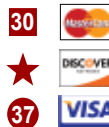
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- Doors open at 4:30pm.

Declutter With Intention

As you start to think about what items should go to the Annual Bazaar, consider the concept of Swedish Death Cleaning. While it sounds a little gruesome, it's about living with more intention, a simple concept from the book, "The Gentle Art of Swedish Death Cleaning", by Margareta Magnusson. The book guides readers through the process of thoughtfully decluttering and organizing possessions, with the aim of easing the burden on loved ones after one's passing. Magnusson encourages individuals to reflect on what truly matters, keep only those items that add value or hold meaning, and let go of guilt associated with parting with belongings.

- Reflect on what matters: Swedish Death Cleaning encourages individuals to thoughtfully consider what possessions truly add value to their lives, keeping only those items that hold meaning or purpose.
- Declutter gradually: Instead of doing everything at once, the process is meant to be done slowly over time, making it less overwhelming and more sustainable.
- Organize for others: The goal is to make things easier for loved ones after you're gone by sorting, organizing, and reducing your belongings, so they aren't burdened with unnecessary items.
- Share stories and memories: As you sort through your possessions, share the stories behind special items with family and friends, passing on memories and traditions.
- Let go of guilt: Swedish Death Cleaning emphasizes letting go of items without feeling guilty, recognizing that it's okay to part with things that no longer serve you or your family.

These concepts help create a more organized, meaningful, and less cluttered life, while also easing the burden on loved ones in the future.





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And The Winner Is.

The Cookbook Book Club (CBBC) started the season with a Favorite Fall Food Challenge where everyone was tasked with making one of their favorite fall recipes, tweaking it with just a small change. At the end of each month's tasting, CBBC participants vote on the favorite recipes of the evening. Thanks to Julie Cincotta for sharing the favorite for October.

Zucchini Bread

Ingredients:

3 cups flour
2 cups sugar
1 1/2 tsp baking soda
1/4 tsp baking powder
1 tsp cinnamon
3 eggs
2 cups grated zucchini
3 tsp vanilla
1 cup veg oil
1/2 cup golden raisins

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 325°.
- Sift the flour, sugar, salt, baking soda, baking powder, and cinnamon 3 times.
- Beat eggs in a bowl. Add to flour mixture along with the zucchini, vanilla, oil, and raisins all at once. Combine all the ingredients. Batter will be dense.
- Pour batter into two greased loaf pans. Bake for one hour.
- I used mini loaf pans, which made the baking time much less. If you were going to use a smaller pan, adjust the bake time. Check it often with a toothpick to see if it comes out clean.

Challenge Tweaks:

For a twist on the recipe, I also added granola and sprinkled cinnamon sugar on the tops before putting it into the oven. Once cooled, I dusted the mini loafs with confectioners' sugar.

Just for Fun

The first Thanksgiving in 1621 lasted three days and was attended by about 50 Pilgrims and 90 Wampanoag Native Americans.

- Turkey wasn't the main dish at the original feast—historians believe venison, duck, and fish were more prominent. Now, approximately 46 million turkeys are cooked for Thanksgiving each year.
- President Abraham Lincoln proclaimed Thanksgiving a national holiday in 1863, during the Civil War.
- The tradition of watching football on Thanksgiving started in 1934, when the Detroit Lions played the Chicago Bears.
- The largest pumpkin pie ever baked weighed over 3,699 pounds and was made in New Bremen, Ohio, in 2010.
- The 2025 winner of the Circleville Pumpkin Show weighed in at 2,226 pounds.
- The Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade has been held annually in New York City since 1924.
- Benjamin Franklin once advocated for the turkey to be the national bird of the United States, instead of the bald eagle.

- **Gate Fobs:** Fobs (like a garage door opener) for the gate between Pointe West and Four Seasons are available for purchase at the Pointe West Office during regular business hours. - **Water Restrictions:** Pointe West’s designated days for watering are Wednesday or Sunday, before 10am and after 4pm.
