There has been a lot of activity in the park and complaints sent to the board. While the board is normally busy keeping the park in good condition and maintaining the park, this month has been particularly busy with pool, spa, sewer, and tree issues along with several complaints from residents that are outside the board's control. Some residents have come to board members' homes when they are relaxing. Please refrain from disturbing board members at home unless it is an emergency.

Reminders:

ear Fellow Residents:

- 1. Please shut your water off and turn off your water heaters when leaving the park for an extended period.
- 2. All rental agreements must be submitted to the office for review.
- 3. Open fires in the park are strictly prohibited.
- 4. Please do not park on the street directly across from another vehicle so that the road is too narrow for emergency vehicles to have access to the street. This is a violation of county regulations, and the park can be fined for this behavior.
- 5. If you clog the toilets in the hall or pool bathrooms, please alert a board member so we can get the issue taken care of. Please don't just leave it for the next person to solve.

Potable Water: A major leak was experienced by one shareholder while the person was in the hospital. This resulted in significant damage to the home. Please have someone check your home when away for any reason to ensure your water is off and hot water heater is off. The county has published water and sewer rates for 2026. LSR expects to see an increase of 4% in water rates next year.

Sewer: There has been a repeat of a mainline sewer clog in one area of the park. This is most likely due to the initial installation of laterals that are connected by a "T" coupler prior to connecting to the main sewer line. This is not the proper method to connect to the main sewer line. A repair will be implemented in the first week of November.

Pool Status: The board has hired an outside contractor to optically scope the drain in the pool to determine where the galvanized pipe extends and to help locate leaks in the drain. This will necessitate the closing of the pool for a day when the work is done. The heaters to the pool were not working for about a week during October. The heaters are now operating to capacity.

Spa: The spa drain was leaking which has forced the spa to be closed. In addition, the spa heater has failed. A new heater will be purchased. The spa heater is now about fifteen (15) years old. The board is evaluating alternatives to the current heating unit for the spa. The leak has now been repaired.



Lake weeds: Lake Seminole is low and the weeds are sprouting from the bottom of the lake. These weeds are not the kind our permit allows us to remove. Our contractor is aware of the weeds and is taking all precautions to spray what we can.

Trees: Thirteen (13) new shade trees were planted in the park to satisfy Pinellas County tree authority. The county held up LSR permits until these trees were planted. The park removed two palm trees that were diseased. One of these palms (a Queen Palm) is on Florida list of undesirable trees. One resident called the county and filed a complaint against the park for removing these trees. The county has notified the board that there is no action necessary and no fines for the removal of these palms. The board is getting quotes to replace the palms destroyed during the hurricane last year. These new palms should be planted within the next 4-8 weeks.

Lift Station Generator: The lift station generator permit was denied because the county could not find the permit for the propane tanks. These tanks are owned by Amerigas. The board is working to find the permits from Amerigas and resolve this issue.

Front Entrance: A survey is being prepared, to be sent to shareholders requesting feedback on the front entrance.

Bathroom by the pool is virtually complete with only a couple of items to be modified.

Grass Treatment: The board is continuing with the limited grass treatment as proposed by the park improvement committee.

Pavers: New pavers were installed in front of the hall for the bicycle stands.

Hall: The hall floor was cleaned and waxed in October. Thanks to Paul Burke and all who helped. The reservation process for the hall and pavilion has been changed. In the past, all reservations were coordinated with Ed Birmingham prior to submitting a request to the board for approval. In the future, the office will confirm the availability of the hall and pavilion. The board thanks Ed for his help and dedication to the park for coordinating the availability of the hall and pavilion.

Complaints: The board addresses all written complaints received. In addition, the board issues letters to shareholders who violate rules or regulations. The names of the people who violate the rules are not normally published unless a fine is required. Then, the Florida statue dictates that the fine be addressed at a board meeting with details of the fine. The board has received several complaints that the board does not enforce the rules and regulations. Since the board does not publish names of violators and actions taken, it is not always known what action the board takes to ensure the rules are uniformly enforced. In October, some (not all) of the complaints sent to the board (either in writing or verbal) included:

- The demand to have a board member removed from the board. The board does not have the authority to unilaterally remove a duly elected board member from the board. This issue cost the homeowners legal fees to resolve.
- Grass clippings left on a driveway. The clippings damaged the concrete.
- Electric bill increased due to wires being cut on air conditioner.
- Sewer clog at the main/lateral junction. This is being repaired.
- Palm tree removal reported to the county for no permit. County responded with no fine or further action.


WINTER SOLSTICE – DECEMBER 21, 2025

In the northern hemisphere, the winter Solstice marks the 24-hour period with the fewest daylight hours of the year. And this year, on Sunday, December 21, 2025 at 10:03 AM, that's what will happen for us Florida-based Northern Hemisphere folks. In terms of daylight, this day is 2 hours, 37 minutes shorter than the June Solstice, which marks the day with the most daylight hours of the year. The good news is that each day after the Winter Solstice has a little more daylight than the day before, right up to the Summer Solstice on Sunday, June 21, 2026.

November 27th through January 4, 2026. It's free to park your car and walk through the park to see the displays. Romance Scams

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can
 use details shared on social media and dating sites to better
 understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone.


Family Scams
