From the Board of Directors Roland Doucette, President

Tappy New Year, Everyone!!! At the Members meeting in November, all items voted on passed. We thank all those who attended in person or by proxy. We had 124 homeowners represented.



There will be a drive-through now that everyone is back to identify and notify homeowners of violations. It would be helpful if you took a few minutes now to check your property for mold, mildew, rust, and other items. We get many positive comments about how nice our community looks from outsiders coming into the park, and your attention to these matters is why we are considered a great-looking community.

January is our coldest month in Blue Jay, and you should be prepared for some possible pool closings due to the outside temperature. The pool may be closed without prior warning if the nighttime temperature reaches 25 degrees below the heater temperature, which is 84 degrees. The heater cannot heat the water sufficiently more than 25 degrees, and so it runs constantly. When this happens, we cover the pool with a heat blanket to avoid damaging the heater, which would be very costly to replace. Hopefully, we can keep these closures to a minimum. Please note that County regulations require the pool area to be locked when the cover is on for safety purposes.

A reminder, Pinellas County requires ALL pets to be on a leash. Please ensure that when you have your pet outdoors, it is always on a leash and under control. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Finally, please respect our Board members by not calling them or visiting their homes with issues that are not emergencies. We do have ways to report issues, either by putting a report in the box at the clubhouse or by coming to our operations meeting at 8:30 AM on Mondays in the clubhouse. Remember, Board members are first residents, and deserve the same privacy at their homes that any other homeowner has. Your cooperation is appreciated.

The next Board meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 20th, at 7pm in the clubhouse. Please mark your calendar and plan to attend.






