#### **Subject: November Monthly Report**

Pool: The month of November has been eventful. The most pressing issue facing the Board is the pool drain. The drain is leaking, and sand is collecting in the pool and clogging the filters. The filters are being cleaned twice a day and even that is not keeping up with the debris in the pool. The Board started working to solve the drain problem early this year. Contractors were brought in to evaluate the drain leak and suggest solutions. At that time the possibilities were relining the drains or replacing the drains. To make an informed decision, the contractors needed to visually scope the pool drains to determine where the galvanized pipes extended and where the major leaks were located. The pool was visually scoped and found to be clogged with iron pipe residue. Since the drains were scoped, the leaks have been getting worse, and the pool is filling with sand and iron residue. The drainpipes were installed in 1959 and should have been replaced twenty years ago. The Board is soliciting bids for drain replacement. This would necessitate the closing of the pool for an extended period of time. As soon as the Board, working with the outside contractors have reached a decision on the appropriate course of action to take, the shareholders will be notified.

**Trees:** thirty (30) palm trees were planted in the park to replace the ones lost in the hurricanes of 2024. Certain residents have complained to our arborist and to the county regarding tree removal. The county found no fault in what LSR has done. All thirteen (13) shade trees required by the county have now been planted. The park is waiting on the county to inspect the trees.

**Speed Bumps:** The speed bumps in the park were inspected and found to be well within the regulations imposed by the county. The speed bumps have now been painted and reflectors added to improve visibility of the speed bumps. Signs have also been posted at the park entrance notifying all who enter the park that there are speed bumps in the park. These actions were necessary because a resident complained that the speed bumps could cause her physical harm, even though this resident refused to take a route through the park to avoid the bumps.

**Parking:** Some residents are still parking on pavers. This is expressly forbidden by the park rules. Phone Books: Updated phone books will be printed and made available to the shareholders in December.

**Spa:** A new heater was installed to support the spa. The spa is now operational. However, the spa draws water from the pool and whatever repair is recommended for the pool will affect the spa.

**Lift Station Generator:** LSR contacted Amerigas and received a copy of the propane tank permits. This was a major holdup in the permitting process for the emergency generator for the lift station. The park is now contracting for a site survey for a flood plain in the park. Apparently, this survey is needed to obtain the county permit for the generator. This survey is a new requirement for LSR.



**Front Entrance:** The survey results solicited from the shareholders regarding the ideas submitted for the front entrance were sent out to all shareholders. The results of the survey were somewhat disappointing since less than a third of the residents responded. Those that did respond were in favor of a minimal upgrade to the entrance and to limit spending on the project.

**Pool Lights:** A petition was given to the Board requesting that pool lights be investigated to allow night swimming. A request was sent to all shareholders to join a group of five on a committee to follow-up on this project. The deadline to join the committee is coming up on 15 December 2025. Thus far, only one shareholder has volunteered to join the committee. If the Board cannot staff the committee with volunteers, the investigation into pool lights will be dropped. Digital Calendar: A new digital calendar has been installed in the office. This will make scheduling the use of the hall and pavilion easier.

**Financial:** The financial reports for November will be posted in the hall. The expense statement for November will be available on the LSR website.




#### THANK YOU TO ALL WHO DONATED TO TOYS FOR TOTS

Journal of the day increase. For example, on January 1, 2026, sunset in Ottawa, Canada is at 4:29 PM, in Pittsburgh, PA it's at 5:05 PM, while in Largo, FL it's at 5:48 PM. 
