GUESTS

RULES AND REGULATIONS MONTHLY REMINDER: GUESTS

- 3. All guests must be registered upon arrival. Guests arriving after office hours must be registered in advance or the next business day when arrival was not anticipated. Residents are responsible to see that their guests wear their assigned guest badges at all times when park facilities and pools are being used.
- 4. Residents are responsible for their guests' actions. Residents will accompany all guests under the age of 18 while such guests use recreational facilities.

DRIVING IN SUGAR CREEK

Vehicles: Golf Carts, bicycles, scooters, skateboards and e-bikes need to follow the same rules as motor vehicles. Stop at the stop signs, obey the speed limit in the park, and most of all watch out for residents pulling out of their driveways. This is for your safety as well as all residents and their families.

If your ACH payments come directly out of your account from Sugar Creek, your lot rent will automatically change to the new amount for 2026 payments. If you use any other method to pay Sugar Creek, please remember to update the amount to avoid any issues.

- Swim at own risk
- Warning no lifeguard on duty
- Maximum load for swimming pool 15 persons 7 persons for spa
- Pool and spa open 24 hours
- Under 18 not permitted in pool or spa from 12:00 noon to 4:00 PM
- Children must be accompanied by resident adult
- Cut offs not allowed in pool
- Shower before entering pool or spa
- No toys, glassware, food or drink in pool, spa or on sun deck no animals
- Suntan lotion prohibited in pool
- Protect furniture with a towel if suntan lotion is used
- · No children in diapers permitted in pool
- No persons with open sores or bandages permitted in pool
- Residents are responsible for guests
- No horseplay in pool or on deck
- No diving
- Pregnant women, small children, people with health problems and people using alcohol, narcotics or other drugs that cause drowsiness should not use spa without first consulting a doctor. The maximum water temperature for the spa is 104 degrees F

The courage to try

ife lessons can come from the most unlikely sources if we are open to receiving what they have to offer us. For Tricia Goyer, a wife, mother, and accomplished author, a lesson In bravery came from her twentysomething son Nathan.

When he announced his plans to write a book, Goyer encouraged him and even promised to edit it once the manuscript was completed. With 500 magazine articles bylines and more than 50 published books of nonfiction and fiction, Goyer knew her insight would be beneficial. She also knew that Nathan had a gift for creating and telling stories, which had been a favorite pastime since his childhood.

As Goyer edited Nathan's rough draft she realized that her son had a talent for writing and decided they should hire a professional editor to review the text. The editor also liked Nathan's work and offered the aspiring novelist some constructive feedback.

After the rewrites were finished, Goyer told her son to start weighing his options about next steps in the publishing process. He could go the traditional route and work with a publisher, or self-publish. Nathan told her he'd need time to think things over and then excused himself to run an errand. He returned a short time later and announced that he would self-publish his work as an e-book. The next day his novel Bask was for sale on Amazon.com. It has even received a few positive reviews.

For Goyer, taking those next steps in the process of publishing one of her many books has never been something she could act on with that kind of certainty or efficiency. She says she would first share copies with as many as 20 friends and consider their feedback. Next she might attend a workshop or conference to solicit even more feedback and advice before deciding which route to take.

Nathan has inspired Goyer to believe that "sometimes we just need to roll up our sleeves and do what we've been afraid to try."
