The courage to try

ife lessons can come from the most unlikely sources if we are open to receiving what they have to offer us. For Tricia Goyer, a wife, mother, and accomplished author, a lesson in bravery came from her twentysomething son Nathan.

When he announced his plans to write a book, Goyer encouraged him and even promised to edit it once the manuscript was completed. With 500 magazine articles bylines and more than 50 published books of nonfiction and fiction, Goyer knew her insight would be beneficial. She also knew that Nathan had a gift for creating and telling stories, which had been a favorite pastime since his childhood.

As Goyer edited Nathan's rough draft she realized that her son had a talent for writing and decided they should hire a professional editor to review the text. The editor also liked Nathan's work and offered the aspiring novelist some constructive feedback.

After the rewrites were finished, Goyer told her son to start weighing his options about next steps in the publishing process. He could go the traditional route and work with a publisher, or self-publish. Nathan told her he'd need time to think things over and then excused himself to run an errand. He returned a short time later and announced that he would self-publish his work as an e-book. The next day his novel Bask was for sale on Amazon.com. It has even received a few positive reviews.

For Goyer, taking those next steps in the process of publishing one of her many books has never been something she could act on with that kind of certainty or efficiency. She says she would first share copies with as many as 20 friends and consider their feedback. Next she might attend a workshop or conference to solicit even more feedback and advice before deciding which route to take.

Nathan has inspired Goyer to believe that "sometimes we just need to roll up our sleeves and do what we've been afraid to try."

Three tips to spark your brain

Personne can be creative, as long as they're willing to give up some preconceptions about what being creative really means. Try these tactics for opening up your mind to innovative possibilities:

• Focus on intuition, not intelligence. You don't have to be a genius to be creative. Train yourself to listen to your feelings, random thoughts, dreams, and intuition. Often ideas and solutions come to us when we aren't looking.

• Give yourself space to think. Collecting data about what you're working on is good, but don't let facts crowd out your creative impulses. Set the information aside and step back to allow your mind to process it without pushing. Build some room inside your head to let ideas grow.

• Try something different. Breaking your routine can lead to creative insights. See the kind of movie you'd never ordinarily watch. Take a walk in a new neighborhood. Fly a kite, or take up a new exercise regimen. Mixing things up can help your mind look at the world in new and different ways, sparking your imagination.

How creative types have gotten into the groove throughout history

ome people take unusual steps to get their creative impulses going. From the Mental Floss website, some examples of how famous folks have jumpstarted their imagination:

- Yoshiro Nakamatsu. This Japanese inventor with more than 3,000 patents to his name dives underwater, holds his breath, and scribbles ideas on a Plexiglas board in his swimming pool.
- Leonardo da Vinci. The Italian artist and inventor honed his creative instincts by taking short naps every four hours throughout the day. He's said to have slept a total of just two hours every day.
- Thomas Edison. This inventor was also a fan of naps, with a twist: He'd sit up holding a handful of marbles and think about the problem he was working on until he fell asleep. When the marbles dropping to the floor woke him up, he wrote down whatever came into his mind, regardless of whether it offered a solution.

Johann Wolfgang von Goethe. The German poet kept a rotten apple on his desk, insisting
that it helped him write more effectively.



Stay healthy by managing your digestion

If you're trying to watch your weight, consider what you know about the digestive process. According to the Medical News Today website, digestion actually begins when food enters the mouth, but the entire process can take 24 to 72 hours. Food high in protein and fats, like meat and fish, takes longer; high-fiber foods like fruit and vegetables are quicker to digest; sweets like candy and pastries are fastest. To improve digestion, follow these guidelines:

• Eat a balanced diet. Concentrate on foods high in fiber: fruits, vegetables, legumes, and whole grains. Limit your meat consumption, along with processed and fast foods.

• **Keep yourself hydrated**. Water, juice and tea keep food moving through the digestive system and help to prevent constipation.

• **Eat probiotics**. These foods supply helpful bacteria that can keep the bacteria in your gut in balance. Try yogurt, kefir, sauerkraut, kimchi, miso, and fermented vegetables.

• Exercise. Regular physical activity aids the digestive tract. A simple walk can relieve bloating, gas, and constipation.

• **Manage your stress**. Stress can slow digestion and cause heartburn, cramping, and bloating. Practice meditation, deep breathing exercises, and yoga.

• **Practice good dental hygiene**. Because digestion begins in the mouth, keeping your teeth in good health is important. Visit a dentist regularly, and be sure to brush and floss daily.

One hour of exercise may relieve depression

eeling depressed? Get moving. As the Medline Plus website reports, a survey of some 34,000 adults found that people who exercise just one hour a week have a 44 percent lower risk of depression over 10 years than those who don't exercise at all.

A Norwegian survey tracked exercise habits along with depression and anxiety risk among people with an average age of 45 who underwent physical exams and filled out questionnaires about their medical needs and lifestyles. The results showed that the intensity of the exercise didn't matter—an hour-long walk provided just as much relief as a high-impact workout.

Exercise didn't appear to have any effect on anxiety risk, but the researchers found that regular exercise for at least one hour per week was connected to a lower risk of depression, regardless of gender or activity intensity.

However, more than an hour's exercise didn't appear to further decrease the risk of depression substantially. Also, the scientists have noted that they haven't proven a direct cause-and-effect relationship between exercise and depression.

Still, it sounds like another good reason to get off the couch and start up a modest exercise routine.



Ancient ocean covered much of Mars

ars may be dry on its surface now, but readings from NASA's Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter (MRO) show that a vast sea existed in the southern highlands approximately 3.7 billion years ago, according to the Sci-News website.

The area, known as the Eridania Basin, contains a mix of such minerals as serpentine, talc, and carbonate, which led NASA researchers to identify possible hydrothermal deposits. The evidence suggests that these deposits were formed by heated water from a volcanically active part of the Mars' crust entering the bottom of a large sea. The sea could have held up to 50,000 cubic miles of water, as much as all other known Martian lakes combined and more than nine times the volume of water in all of North America's Great Lakes.

In addition to being important to the exploration of Mars, the seafloor deposits also provide a glimpse into the early life of Earth. The earliest evidence of life on our planet comes from similar deposits, but the geological record is poorly preserved, NASA scientists say.

New method of invisibility on the horizon

arry Potter's cloak of invisibility may be magic, but scientists are trying to perfect a real "beam of invisibility," according to the Fox News website.

Most attempts to render an object invisible involve guiding light waves around its structure in a smooth manner that produces only a ripple. A new approach, devised by scientists at the Technical University of Vienna, calls for using a laser to pump an object full of energy from above. By altering the material's properties, the process allows light beams to move through the object in a straight line instead of being scattered in all directions.

The object has to be irradiated according to its own specific pattern. The scientists have developed a method to calculate the correct pattern for any structure that would scatter light waves. Although it hasn't been tested yet, researchers are optimistic, although they caution that finding practical applications may take a long time.

Follow these tips to avoid accidents at home

very year about 30,000 fatal accidents occur in people's homes, most of which were largely preventable. Making your home accident-proof isn't hard. To make sure your home is a safe home, review this safety checklist:

- Stairwells, stoops and steps. Tack down loose carpeting, augment dim lighting, and bolt handrails to walls with long screws.
- Exterior walkways and steps. If painted, repaint with a nonslip additive that prevents slipping or affix with nonslip strips.
- Electric garage door. Test periodically to make sure the safety stop mechanism is operational.
- Free-standing furniture. Secure bookshelves and storage units to walls with angled brackets, screws or bolts.
- Gas and water cutoff valves. Know how to close them. Use tags to identify each one, if necessary.
- **Heating and water system**. Have the vent stacks professionally checked annually to prevent toxic gases from entering the home.
- Water heater. Set temperature at or below 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Test highest temperature in running water with meat thermometer. Alternatively, install an anti-scald device on faucets and showerheads.
- Clothes dryer. Make sure it vents directly outside, not through a chimney flue, as lint is combustible and the fumes can be toxic.
- **Radiators**. Cover with a frame that is not touching the unit.
- Steam irons. Always unplug before filling with water.
- **Toasters**. Avoid toasting sugarcoated or filled pastries because the sugar can ooze, gumming up the inside and causing a fire.
- All appliances. Check to make sure they have UL listings, which guarantee the product meets safety standards. And make sure electrical appliances are not next to heating equipment.
- Light switches. Relocate any that are within reaching distance of a tub or shower.
- Electrical cords and plugs. Replace any worn piece, as they cause many household fires. Keep out of high traffic areas where they can trip children and adults. And never run under carpeting or rugs.
- Extension cords. Avoid using. If necessary, use cords with the same or greater wattage/amperage than the appliance. Never run under carpeting or rugs.

• Electrical panel box. Ensure there's a main disconnect to cut off all power in case of a fire. Also, properly mark all circuit breakers.
