FROM THE OFFICE


Welcome to 2026! Hard to believe that another year has gone by, and we are all another year older (but not necessarily wiser).

You should notice an increase in your Social Security Check; the average increase is \$56, based on a 2.8% cost of living increase. The Medicare Part B insurance rate has increased to \$202.90; you can reduce this to zero by going to a Medicare advantage insurance program. The new enrollment time frame ended on December 7th, but there are some exceptions. I recommend you contact an insurance advisor to find out what your options are.... several companies include a monthly spending card, which can be used for groceries and over-the-counter medications.



All Embassy rent amounts have increased by \$60, starting with your January rent. Please make sure you submit the correct amount, write the amount correctly, and the “words” on the

legal line are correct. In addition, all checks must be written in blue or black ink, or they will be returned to you. Your rent is considered late if the office does not receive a valid form of payment by the close of business on the 5th of the month (unless you have made other arrangements with the Office). A reminder that late fees are \$30 after the 5th of the month, NOT prorated by how many days you are late. Additionally, the bank returned check fee is \$30 and an administrative fee of \$5 is charged for handling. Simply put, if you pay late or issue an improper check, it will cost you an additional \$65. I am happy to work with anyone who has a legitimate reason for being late; “legitimate” does not include “I am going on vacation and need to have the extra money in case I need it”! Or “I had to pay my son’s rent, so he didn’t get evicted.” And yes, I hear this all the time. Also, if you have a 3rd person approved to live in your mobile, the monthly fee has increased to an additional \$50 per person.

Within the last 2 months, every resident should have received a letter about any repairs that were needed to bring their yard and mobile home up to Park standards; some people received letters thanking them for keeping their mobile and lot in good condition (We called them “Happy Letters”). Joelle has been the one checking the mobiles and lots, then sending out the letters. She then forwards me any pictures she may have taken to substantiate items that needed attention. She will be doing follow-ups to see if the needed repairs have been made. Rules 21 and 39 give Park Management the right to be on your lot for this purpose.

Here is a large problem we have encountered.... residents seem to think these are “suggestions” and that the time frame for repairs does not apply to them. WRONG! You can come see me or send an email and explain why you may need more time, and it will be at my discretion whether or not you are given additional time. Things not acceptable are: we need to put money inside first; we may do it in the spring; we are ok with the way things are; I’m too old to do the work (then you hire someone); it’s been this way forever (times change, Embassy was starting to look like a trailer park instead of a mobile home community); etc.

Park Rule 18. TRASH/GARBAGE, items B, C, and D, give guidance on putting garbage out to the road. I cannot stress enough about garbage being put out on a Saturday, or other wrong time. No one wants to look at your trash, and it leaves a bad impression on guests and prospective new tenants who drive through the park. Understanding that a lot of residents have no golf cart, truck or other way to get the large amount of brush, limbs, etc. to the dumpsters after they received cleanup letters, I did make an exception and had maintenance pick it up after the letters went out, but normally if you put garbage out early, or don’t properly prepare your limbs, etc. your garbage will not be picked up AT ALL. It will be your problem getting it to the dumpsters.

Even though park rules allow for eviction of residents who continually break the rules (and don’t follow up on the repairs indicated in the letters), it is not our intent. I would rather work

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with you to find a solution.....there are still a few residents who are physically able (and young enough) to do some of the required work at a reasonable price. There are businesses that advertise power washing for just under \$100 in the News and Views. Park rules require mobile homes to be washed annually, but if at any time mold or mildew becomes visible, you are required to wash it again. Weather affects mold and mildew, and the record setting high temperatures and humidity that we had this summer caused many residents to wash their mobiles several times. Mold is a living organism that grows and spreads when it has the right conditions, such as damp, warm and humid environments. If you see signs of mold starting, you should remove it immediately, so it doesn't become a bigger issue. Washing of mobile homes is not subject to Pinellas County water restrictions.

We are still under water restrictions, (2 days a week, Thursday and Sunday) but NOT permitted between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Also, park rules allow car washing only twice a week (a week is defined as Sunday through Saturday).

Holiday hours:

The Office will be closed December 23rd through January 1, 2026. It will reopen on Friday, January 2nd.

Maintenance will do **Garbage ONLY** on December 24th and 26th and 31st. They will work their regular hours on December 29th and 30th, then return to 5 days a week starting January 2, 2026. Roy will be available for emergency situations throughout the holidays; emergencies consist of water leaks, plumbing and electrical issues that fall under the Park's responsibility; he will come and look to determine what the issue is. I will be out of state December 26th through 30th but will monitor emails the entire holiday period (December 23rd through January 1st.) If you are having guests who stay over 48 hours during this time, send a picture of valid photo ID and the dates that they will be visiting to me via email, or put copies with the dates in the mail slot on the office door.

I apologize for the length of this article regarding mobile home lot and home maintenance, but, like most of you, I do not want to live in a "trailer park" and I expect all residents to take some pride in their home and yard.

Welcome to 2026 and may we all have a healthy year!

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

ONE POT CAJUN CHICKEN AND RICE

Ingredients:

- 1 medium onion (about 6 ounces), cut into large pieces
- 2 medium celery stalks, cut into large pieces
- 1 medium green bell pepper (about 6 ounces), seeded and cut into large pieces
- 2 TBS vegetable oil
- 2 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves, cut into 1-inch pieces, with visible fat removed
- 2 1/4 teaspoons Cajun or Creole seasoning, divided, or to taste
- 1 1/2 cups uncooked, long grain white (or brown) rice
- 2 cloves garlic, minced or finely grated
- 1/2 tsp salt, or to taste
- 1/4 tsp freshly ground black pepper, or to taste
- 2 1/2 cups whole or 2% milk
- 1/2 cup low sodium chicken broth, or water (or more as needed)
- 4 scallions, sliced (optional for garnish)



Directions:

STEP 1: In a large sauté pan or Dutch oven, heat the oil over medium heat until shimmering. In a large bowl, toss the chicken with 1 teaspoon of the Cajun seasoning blend and add to the pan in a single layer. Cook without stirring until lightly browned on the bottom, 4 to 5 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer to a plate.

STEP 2: Cook the onion, celery and bell pepper mixture in the same pan, stirring occasionally until softened; about 5 minutes. Add the rice, garlic, salt, pepper, and the remaining seasoning and stir to incorporate. Cook for 1-2 minutes; then add the milk and broth/water, stirring so nothing sticks to the bottom of the pan.

STEP 3: Bring the mixture to a gentle simmer. Return the chicken and any of its accumulated juices to the pan. Let the mixture come back to a simmer. Stir, then reduce the heat to medium low. Cover and cook until the chicken is cooked through, about 15 minutes. Check occasionally to make sure it's not simmering too vigorously; give it a stir to make sure nothing is sticking on the bottom.

STEP 4: Once the chicken is cooked through and the rice is tender, remove from the heat. The liquid may look a bit like curdled milk on the surface; this is okay. Let the chicken and rice sit, covered, for five minutes. Then uncover and give it a good stir. If it seems too thick, add more broth/water (up to 1/4 cup), as needed.

STEP 5: Scatter scallions on top and serve family style.

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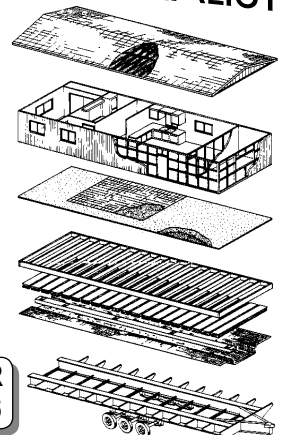
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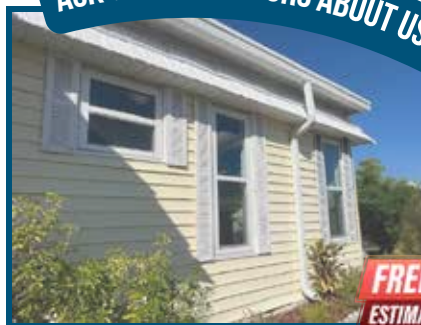
