2017 HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION ANNUAL DUES DRIVE

mber Glades Inc. (Our Homeowners Association), is conducting our dues drive for 2017. The Homeowners Association is formed under Florida Statue 723 and its task is dealing with park management over rules, maintenance issues, grievances and rent. Our normal expenses are relatively low with the exception of legal fees when required and our liability insurance. Most issues are settled amicably by meeting with park management. However, there are times we need to engage an attorney to assist. Legal help is expensive, most of our dues collected will be set aside for future legal expense. By being a paid up member of Amber Glades Inc., you will be eligible for our monthly lot number drawing at the Social Committee meetings, you will pay 25% less for tickets to all events, also you can place an ad on Channel 95/724, our community TV Channel, for \$2.00 a month rather than the normal \$20.00 per ad per month. ONLY paid members for 2017 may attend and vote at the annual meeting of the association. You will also have the satisfaction of knowing that you are a participating member of this community. The annual fee for membership in the Association is \$15.00 which can be put in an envelope and dropped off in the deposit box next to sliding door at the club house or given to any board member. Checks must be drawn on a United States bank in US dollars. If you have already paid your 2017 dues and have your sticker displayed in your window we thank you very much.







AMBER GLADES PAST...REMEMBERED

[This article appeared in the October 2006 issue of the Amber Glades Monthly Media by Catherine Barrowman. For you newer folks, Catherine was a former, well-loved, resident who volunteered for many things in the park.]

ompared with today's traffic and surrounding development, Amber Glades was "in the boonies" in 1972 – a brand new Mobile Home community – a nice quiet area bordered by McMullen-Booth scenic corridor on the west and State Road580 on the north, with no traffic light at the intersection of these four-lane roads. Our address was 2801 SR 580, Clearwater.

The new residents had one thing in common. They came as strangers, closing one door "up north" and opening another here, and it was the beginning of a great new adventure. It wasn't long before Amber Glades was a bee-hive of activity. Down to business, folks!

Sept. 11, 1972 was the date of the first meeting of residents to organize an association for recreational activities.

Sept. 13 – A nominating committee met to prepare a slate of officers.

Sept. 18 – Recreational by-laws committee presented a slate of officers.

Sept. 25 – At the general meeting Glyn Piper, #114, was elected as first president of Amber Glades Recreation Association and Ruth Hutton, #141, accepted the task of Social Director. Mary Hummer, #340, served on several committees.

Meanwhile, the very first of the Social Activities in Amber Glades was a buffet supper and party on September 16. Menu included six fried chickens, Swedish meatballs, salad, and several "libations". Seventy five persons partied, and Amber Glades was off and running!
