

HOA BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS.....DECEMBER 1, 2015

Il seven board members were present along with 12 guests from the park. The treasurer reported 21,415.12 in the treasury.

It was announced that patchwork to the roads is scheduled, according to Scott, and that the kitchen will be remodeled starting January 4, 2016. A concern about smoke detectors in the clubhouse was going to be discussed with Scott at their upcoming monthly meeting.

A recycling of hazardous materials and bulky items has been scheduled for December 15th by Amber Glades, in the clubhouse parking lot, as it was last time. Flyers will go out to residents about this.

The board has drafted a letter to the owners of Amber Glades concerning a reduction in services pertaining to the lawn service and roadways. This is being sent directly to the Michigan office.

The board discussed the annual letter going out to residents from the HOA. Wayne Fletcher stated that the correct information sheets will be donated by FMO to be included in the annual letter to residents. These letters will go out to residents next week and besides FMO information it will include proxy cards for the upcoming election and voting information. Four board positions are up for election. The four board members holding these positions are running for re-election. A nominating committee was formed consisting of two HOA Board Members, Wayne Fletcher and Ed O'Neal, and one resident, ML Faiola.



The Homeowners Association is formed under Florida Statue 723 and its task is dealing with park management over rules, maintenance issues, grievances and rent.

Our normal expenses are relatively low with the exception of legal fees when required and our liability insurance. Most issues are settled amicably by meeting with park management. However, there are times we need to engage an attorney to assist. Legal help is expensive, most of our dues collected will be set aside for future legal expense.

By being a paid up member of Amber Glades Inc., you will be eligible for our monthly lot number drawing at the Social Committee meetings, you will pay 25% less for tickets to all events, also you can place an ad on Channel 95/724, our community TV Channel, for \$2.00 a month rather than the normal \$20.00 per ad per month. **ONLY** paid members for 2016 may attend and vote at the annual meeting of the association. You will also have the satisfaction of knowing that you are a participating member of this community.

The annual fee for membership in the Association is \$15.00 which can be put in an envelope and dropped off in the deposit box next to sliding door at the club house or given to any board member. Checks must be drawn on a United States bank in US dollars.



RIVIA OUESTION – Where was the largest New Year Millennium Eve (2000) celebration on earth?



ANSWER – Right here in Florida at the **Big Cypress Indian Reservation**. 85,000 people were in attendance for the week long Phish Concert. Fans camping out, as they do at most Phish concerts. It was also the longest Phish concert ever, culminating in a seven-and-a-half hour second set from midnight to sunrise New Year's Day. The band's performance of "Heavy Things" was broadcast during ABC's millennium coverage. Following the song, at the band's request, the audience chanted the word "cheesecake" instead of cheering to confuse viewers at home. As it turned out, the broadcast cut away before the gag could be pulled off. Phish was the only band at the event, performing five sets of music (nearly sixteen hours) over two nights. Portable toilets were on stage for the band members. As fans left the concert area at sunrise on New Year's Day, The Beatles' "Here Comes the Sun" played over the PA speakers.

More trivia info (you probably didn't need to know!): My oldest son and seven friends were among the 85,000. Phish fans for life.

MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY **OBSERVED JANUARY 18, 2016**

Tartin Luther King Day is observed on the third Monday of January which is close to King's birthday of January 15. Martin Luther King, Jr was known in United States history for his influential role in civil rights and racial equality. The Federal holiday was first observed in 1983 after President Ronald Reagan signed it into law three years prior. Not until the year 2000 did all fifty states officially observe this day.

Martin Luther King, Jr. advocated a non-violent approach to reaching his goals of an end to segregation in the United States. He is famous for his speech, "I Have a Dream." He was assassinated in 1968. Labor Unions were influential in establishing a Federal Holiday in his name. Six million signatures were collected to petition Congress to pass the law. It became law by 1983 after musician Stevie Wonder released "Happy Birthday" single in 1980 to spread the campaign and hosted the Rally for Peace Press Conference in 1981.

FMO (FEDERATION OF MANUFACTURED HOMEOWNERS OF FLORIDA)

You may have seen the FMO stickers in some residents' windows and wondered what they were. FMO is the Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida.

What does the FMO do, and how does this relate to you?

The FMO is a watchdog standing guard for the residents of parks like our own – but the parks must maintain an active membership in the FMO. There are lobbyists in Tallahassee working for the FMO; they keep close tabs on what lawmakers are doing and what impact changes to laws have upon homeowners like us. The FMO works closely with homeowners' associations but does not replace the association.

Who can Join?

Anyone can join FMO. A base membership is \$22.00 per coach (not per resident).

Why Should I Join?

The real question is: Why shouldn't you join? The more members that the FMO has, the more influence they have in Tallahassee. Politicians are swayed by voting blocks and with a strong membership we can all have a voice in what happens to our future.

Monthly meetings are held at various parks – September through April. All members are welcome to attend. Also, a bi-monthly magazine is sent to member coaches.

AN AMBER GLADE RESIDENT YOU SHOULD MEET

ong time Amber Glades resident, Ginger Gustafson, has lived in the park since March of 1980. Personal computers were just making their appearance at that time and cell phones weren't common for another 15 years. Both of these, Ginger lives without. She prefers life to go a little slower. She enjoyed the times when you walked down the street to talk to each other, when you depended on each other for entertainment and when everyone joined in the activities that were planned by the park volunteers. No one stayed home when an activity was going on, everyone joined in the fun.

There were no fences around Amber Glades back then and the roads weren't even named back in 1980. Ginger says Margaret (last name forgotten) decided the roads needed names and made the decision to name them after gems.

In those early years in Amber Glades, Ginger tells of all the activities they had: Tea Parties, Fancy Hat Parties, Pool Parties, BBQ's, Exercise classes (complete with leotards), Water Aerobics, groups of walkers and fashion shows. Many of these activities Ginger helped organize or lead. She recalls one pool party that the Amber Glades Synchronized Swimmers performed at along with a pool-side singer for entertainment.

Ginger says she has put in her time planning activities and has now let the younger residents take over. That does not mean she is slowing down. Her home is a testament to her skill and
