President's Message

It's hard to believe that we are in the midst of Summertime. The heat and humidity are here in full swing as well as the use of our air conditioning. Some of us escape the heat by utilizing the pool. Even on the hottest of days it is very refreshing. Remember to stay hydrated. You don't realize how much fluid your body loses in this heat.

MAINTAINING THE PARK: By the time of this publication our new roof should be completed on the Clubhouse and Atrium. Our maintenance staff will start working on exchanging our old and faded STOP signs for new bright STOP signs. All the palm trees have been trimmed and the dead trees removed. Maintaining the park is an ongoing process.

FRIENDLY REMINDER: When walking your pet keep a bag in your pocket or on leash and use it to pick up after pets immediately and dispose of it properly. There are numerous areas with pet waste bags and containers. We ask you to use them.

We are entering the heart of HURRICANE SEASON. The gulf waters are hot which aids in hurricane formations and giving them power. Check your supplies. If you have pets, be sure their rabies and other shots are current, and you have documentation if you plan on using a shelter. Do you have your important papers together and other supplies you will need if you must evacuate? Make a plan, supply the plan, and then if need be, work the plan. BE PREPARED!

The one good thing about a hurricane (if there can be one good thing) is the amount of warning time you get. Usually it is several days. This is the time to be sure EVERY item in your yard or carport is moved inside. This would include statues, plant pots, chairs, swings, bikes, tables, etc. These will all become flying missiles in winds of 80-100+ mph. If you are "watching" a neighbor's home for the summer, please be sure to remove their items as well. If you are going on an extended vacation, say 2-3 weeks, your home should have items removed to the inside or have a neighbor be responsible.

We've been lucky so far but being prepared is like having an umbrella when they forecast rain. You think it won't happen, but you take it anyway.

BE SAFE everyone.



Manager's Message

<u>I urricane Season</u> – Hurricane Season has begun and lasts through the end of November. Be sure you are prepared in advance for a storm by picking up a 2019 hurricane guide in the business office.

<u>Clubhouse/Atrium Roof</u> – The clubhouse and atrium roofs are in the process of being replaced by MaintenX Roofing. All work should be completed by the end of August. Please be sure to stay away from areas that are taped off for safety reasons.

<u>Town Hall Meeting</u> – This month's Town Hall Meeting with the Board of Directors is scheduled for Wednesday, August 14th at 6:30 PM in the Clubhouse. Come share your ideas and learn what your board and management team are working on.

<u>Fertilization</u> – Incorrect use of fertilizer can allow nutrients to leach into the groundwater and wash into storm drains that flow to creeks, lakes, Tampa Bay, and/or the Gulf of Mexico. Excess nutrients can cause harmful algae blooms, which lower oxygen levels and lead to fish kills. The treatment to remove these nutrients costs taxpayers millions of dollars each year. Nutrient pollution can be controlled with your help. An ounce of prevention is worth a ton of cure! Retailers cannot sell any fertilizer that contains nitrogen or phosphorous between June 1 – September 30 each year. Please refrain from using these products during the summer months.

<u>Vespers</u> – Vespers is looking for a choir director/accompanist. As many of you know, we have a beautiful facility for practice and service. They have a 14-member choir and a Yamaha Junior Clavinova. Vesper services begin the 1st Sunday of November and run through Easter sunrise. Sunday service is from 4:50 to 5:45. Choir rehearsals are one hour starting 2 weeks before the 1st Sunday of November. They have been rehearsing on Fridays but can be flexible. They have an extensive music library. The weekly commitment 1 hour of practice and 2 hours of performance, and the pay rate is \$35 per hour. Please contact Martha Sutton if interested.

<u>Irrigation</u> – There's nothing more wasteful or more embarrassing than a sprinkler system that runs when it doesn't have to - in the rain. The simplest and most effective way to prevent sprinklers from coming on during or after a rain event is by installing a rain sensor, also known as a rain shut-off device. Easily installed on most automatic time clocks, this device shuts sprinklers off after a certain amount of rainfall has occurred. A properly installed and functioning sensor can save up to 20% of your water use while preventing plant and lawn maintenance problems from over-watering. Helping Hands - What is Parkinson's Disease?

Parkinson's disease (PD) is a progressive disorder that affects movement, muscle control, and balance, as well as numerous other functions. It is one of a group of motor systems disorders. Parkinson's disease was named for James Parkinson, a general practitioner in London during the 19th century who first described the symptoms of the disease. However, similar symptoms have appeared in writings in India and China over 7,000 years ago. Parkinson's disease is the most common movement disorder and the second most common neurodegenerative disorder, the most common being Alzheimer's disease.

The hallmark symptoms of Parkinson's disease are tremors at rest, rigidity, and slowness in movement. There is currently no cure for Parkinson's disease. It is always chronic and progressive, meaning that the symptoms get worse over time. How fast the disease will progress varies from person to person, as will the intensity of the symptoms. But Parkinson's disease itself is not fatal, and many people live into their older years. Parkinson's disease patients usually die due to secondary complications such as pneumonia or falling-related injuries. Stem cell treatment may provide a new way to deal with Parkinson's. Proper treatment and follow up are very important.




Model Home Arrives




