President's Message

Infortunately, this past month several Americana Cove residents were victims of theft. The joint efforts of Signal 88 and the St Petersburg Police Department apprehended an individual. While we have been relieved with the arrest, it does not mean we should let our guard down.

At the Security Meeting held by Signal 88, we had an attendance of over 200 residents

where ways of protecting your property were discussed.

With that in mind, do you have insurance coverage to protect your losses? Do you feel you don't need insurance to cover losses occurred by natural disasters? In a recent National Association of Insurance Commissioners national survey, about 48 percent of homeowners and renters said they did not have an inventory of their possessions. Of those who reported having a checklist, 32 percent had not taken any pictures and 58 percent had no receipts validating the cost of their possessions. In addition, 44 percent acknowledged that they had not stored their inventory in a separate location.

Here are some tips from the NAIC to help you prepare for disasters:

1. Take an inventory of your valuables and belongings. This should include taking photographs or a video of each room. This documentation will provide your insurance company with proof of your belongings and help to process claims more quickly in the event of disaster.

2. To enable filing claims more quickly, keep sales receipts and canceled checks. Also note

the model and serial numbers of the items in your home inventory.

3. As you acquire more valuables such as jewelry or antiques, consider purchasing an additional floater or rider to your policy to cover these special items. These types of items typically are not covered by a basic homeowner's or renter's insurance policy.

4. Remember to include in your home inventory those items you rarely use such as holiday

decorations, sports equipment and tools.

5. Store copies of all your insurance policies in a safe location away from your home that is easily accessible in case of disaster. You may want to store your policies and inventory in a waterproof, fireproof box or in a safe location such as a bank safe deposit box.

6. Consider leaving a copy of your inventory with relatives, friends or your insurance provider and store digital pictures in your e-mail, safe deposit box, or on a website for

easy retrieval.

7. Know what is and is not covered by your insurance policy. You might need additional protection depending on where you live. Make sure your policies are up to date. Contact your insurance provider annually to review and update your insurance policy.

8. Keep a readily available list of 24-hour contact information for each of your insurance

providers.

- 9. Find out if your possessions are insured for the actual cash value or the replacement cost. Actual cash value is the amount it would take to repair or replace your home and possessions after depreciation, while replacement cost is the amount it would take to repair or replace your home or possessions without deducting for depreciation. Speak with your insurance provider to determine whether purchasing replacement coverage is worth the cost.
- 10. Speak with your insurance provider to find out if your policy covers additional living expenses for a temporary residence if you are unable to live in your home due to damage from a disaster.
- 11. Appraise your home periodically to make sure your insurance policy reflects home improvements or renovations. Contact your insurance provider to update your policy.
