#### Manager's Message

<u>I urricane Season</u> – Hurricane Season has begun and lasts through the end of November. Be sure you are prepared in advance for a storm by picking up a 2019 hurricane guide in the business office.

<u>Clubhouse/Atrium Roof</u> – The clubhouse and atrium roofs are in the process of being replaced by MaintenX Roofing. By the time this is published, this work should be substantially complete.

<u>Town Hall Meeting</u> – This month's Town Hall Meeting with the Board of Directors is scheduled for Wednesday, September 11th at 2:30 p.m. in the Clubhouse. Come share your ideas and learn what your board and management team are working on.

Fertilization – Incorrect use of fertilizer can allow nutrients to leach into the groundwater

and wash into storm drains that flow to creeks, lakes, Tampa Bay, and/or the Gulf of Mexico. Excess nutrients can cause harmful <u>algae blooms</u>, which lower oxygen levels and lead to <u>fish kills</u>. The treatment to remove these nutrients costs taxpayers millions of dollars each year. Nutrient pollution can be controlled with your help. "An ounce of prevention is worth a ton of cure!" Retailers cannot sell any fertilizer that contains nitrogen or phosphorous between June 1 – September 30 each year. Please refrain from using these products during the summer months.

<u>Irrigation</u> – There's nothing more wasteful, or more embarrassing, than a sprinkler system that runs when it doesn't have to ... in the rain. The simplest, most effective way to prevent sprinklers from coming on during or after a rain event is by installing a rain sensor, also known as a rain shut-off device. Easily installed on most automatic time clocks, this device shuts sprinklers off after a certain amount of rainfall has occurred. A properly installed and functioning sensor can save up to 20% of your water use while preventing plant and lawn maintenance problems from over-watering. For a limited time, the City of St. Petersburg is offering a free sprinkler system evaluation (including free installation of a rain sensor!). Contact the office for more information.

<u>Gate Access</u> – If you call the gate to add a visitor to the access log and get voice mail, please leave a message and the attendant on duty will return your call as quickly as possible. In addition, please remember that contractors/vendor are not permitted to begin working until 8:00 a.m.

<u>Trash</u> – Please remember that if you place your trash out for pick up the night before trash day, it must be in a container with a lid. When bags are placed out overnight, they are often torn open by animals, creating a mess for the maintenance staff. Thanks for your help with this.

<u>Labor Day</u> – The office will be closed on Monday, September 2nd for the Labor Day Holiday.







f you had chickenpox as a child, you might recall the itchy, spotted rash that popped up on your face and body. The varicella zoster virus that causes chickenpox stays inside your body for many years. 
Once you're older, that same virus can wake up and cause shingles. It gives you a rash, too, but it's often more painful than itchy. A blistering rash on one side of your body can be a sign you have it. See your doctor to find out for sure. Once you've been diagnosed, you can get treated to help relieve your rash and other symptoms.

#### A shingles rash:

- Appears on one side of your body and/or face.
- Stings, burns, and/or itches.
- Starts as red bumps that form into blisters.

Some people who get shingles fit in these categories:

- A weakened immune system, which can wake the virus up.
- Having had chickenpox.
- Cancer, HIV, or another disease that lower your body's defense.
- Being 50 or older.
- Being under a lot of stress.
- Past physical trauma.
- Taking long-term steroids or other medicines that can weaken your immune system.



Those people who have had shingles are the first to recommend the vaccine. Prevention is the best way to deal with shingles!


